The youngsters spent half their time in classes and the rest was spent in nature study courses taught by Ed Macdonald. The 'classroom' was the old Altona mill pond and the surrounding rural countryside.

Barb Wideman, assisted by Doreen Brown, taught the classroom subjects to both her and Mr. Macdonald's classes.

For the past two years the senior classes

spent a week at Pioneer Village where they were expected to fit themselves into the display.

There is a three year waiting list for Pioneer Village (the school only got in last year because it was the town's centennial) so the staff and students decided to spend a week at the Altona Community Centre.

The money for hall rental and bus fare was raised by the students who held a penny carnival at the school. Around \$250 was collected.

Mr. Macdonald commented that if anything, the children enjoyed themselves more at Altona than they did at the village. "They didn't have the pressure," he said.
