# The steam era recalled

## 3000 atshow

UXBRIDGE - "You know, the steam age was really wonderful," reflected Francis Hockley, of Sandford.

Mr. Hockley and his 1922 George White steam engine was one of the many exhibits that rekindled memories of bygone days at seventh annual "heritage festival," at the Uxbridge-Scott Museum.

About three thousand people attended the two day event, organized by the: Uxbridge-Scott Historical Society.

"We've been getting bigger every year," explained Isobel St. John, president of the organization.

She called it an event "for the whole family," including displays of candle-making, spinning, kite-making, and dancing performed by Indian children from the Ottawa Valley.

The affair began, she explained, to give their organization a reason for being. They're collecting items to preserve the past for people, she said, "so we bring them out and demonstrate them."

Bill Woods, chairman of the Steam Show, was raised in the steam era. "I was twelve years old when I fired my first engine," he recalled.

According to Mr. Woods, these machines played "an important part in our history" from about 1860 to the 1930's, when the gas tractor was introduced.
