brought rebuttals from two sides.

Betty Palmer, also a Lake resident, said she too had served on the same Board but couldn't recall him "really attending many meetings".

She was backed by the chairman, Bill Morrison, who stated that out of 32 meetings in 2 1/2 years, Robb had missed eighteen, then resigned. Robb admitted

quitting the committee saying he was in disagreement with some of the things the Board was doing at the time.

"Are you going to do the same thing on Council, quit half way through?" Morrison shot back.

The candidate claimed council business was entirely different. "I'll be representing more people," he said.

His desire to consult with the electorate on major issues, also incurred criticism from Morrison. "If I hire a guy to do a job, I expect him to do it, not ask how it's to be done. How can you possibly poll the people on every issue?"

Ron Robb said his main aim was to keep the democratic process alive by forcing an election in Ward 2 and to this end, he had been successful. "I believe we both learned of a few problems here tonight".

The remaining questions were fielded by incumbent councillor Becky Wedley. They dealt with everything from snow removal to garbage collection.

About 65 people attended. Mayor-elect Eldred King served as moderator.

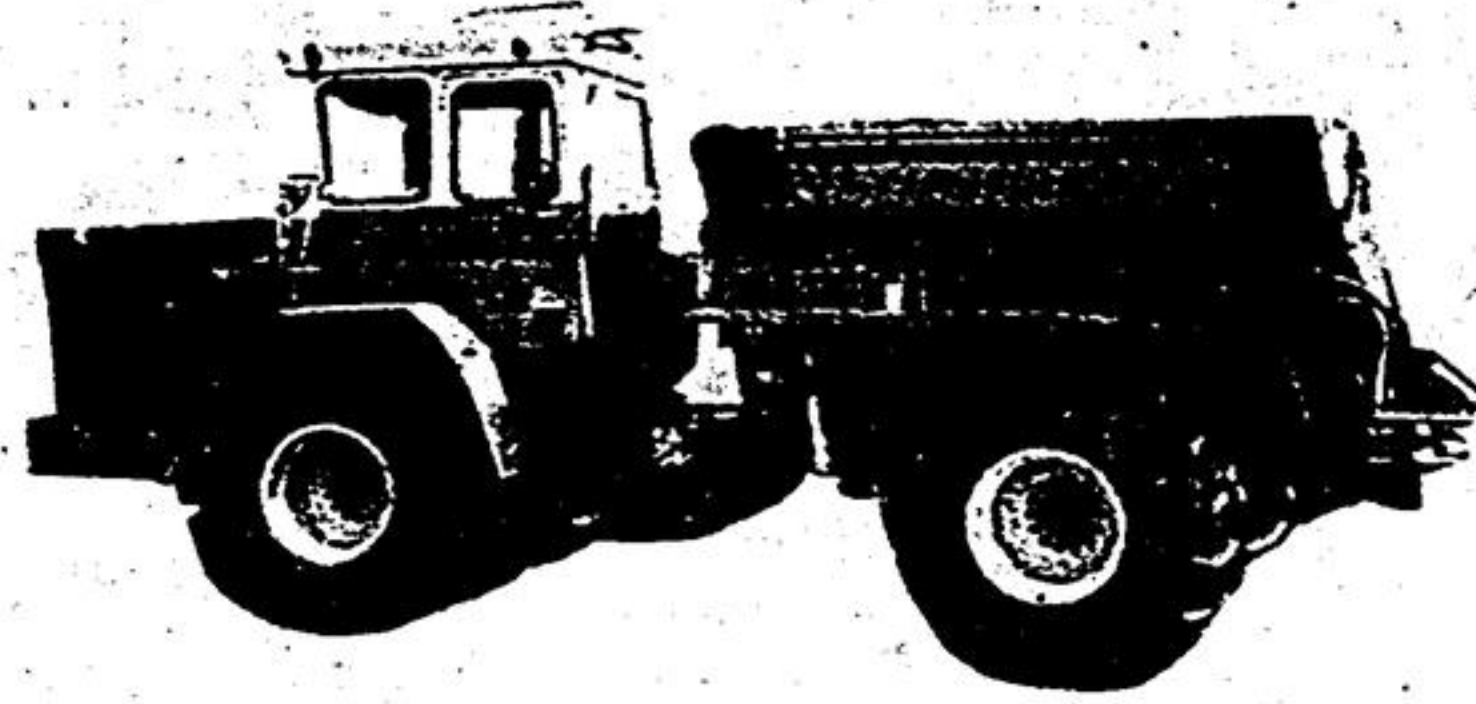
