## Crime is everywhere

STOUFFVILLE — Crime is not confined to Yonge Street, Toronto, it's in Stouffville, Musselman's Lake, Mount Albert — it's everywhere." Constable Fred Tufnell of York Regional Police told a meeting of the Silver Jubilee Club, Jan. 19.

P. C. Tufnell described how people often "invite" crime by walking along dark streets alone at night; leaving keys in the ignition of cars and by failing to leave a night light on in stores and business places after hours.

While admitting that "no lock in the world will prevent a break-in if there's a window in the house", the speaker urged his audience to have "peep-holes" installed in apartment doors. This allows the owner to see who's on the outside but the person outside can't see in. The cost, he said, is five or six dollars.

Never, he said, call out to any party, saying "the door's open, come on in". That's inviting trouble, he warned.

Constable Tufnell also advised home owners and tenants to make sure they keep a list of all valuables, also the serial numbers of all appliances. This, he said, is an aid to police and insurance companies should a robbery occur.
