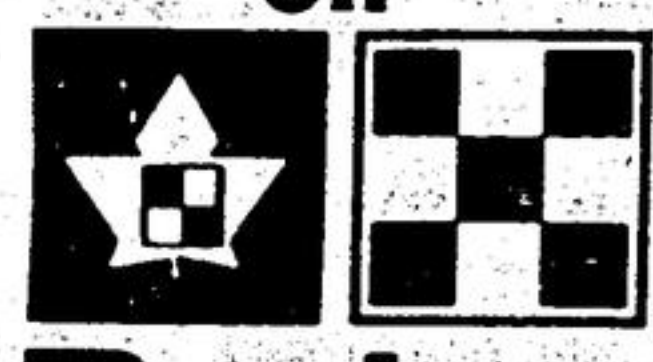
Sisters canvass to re-build monastery

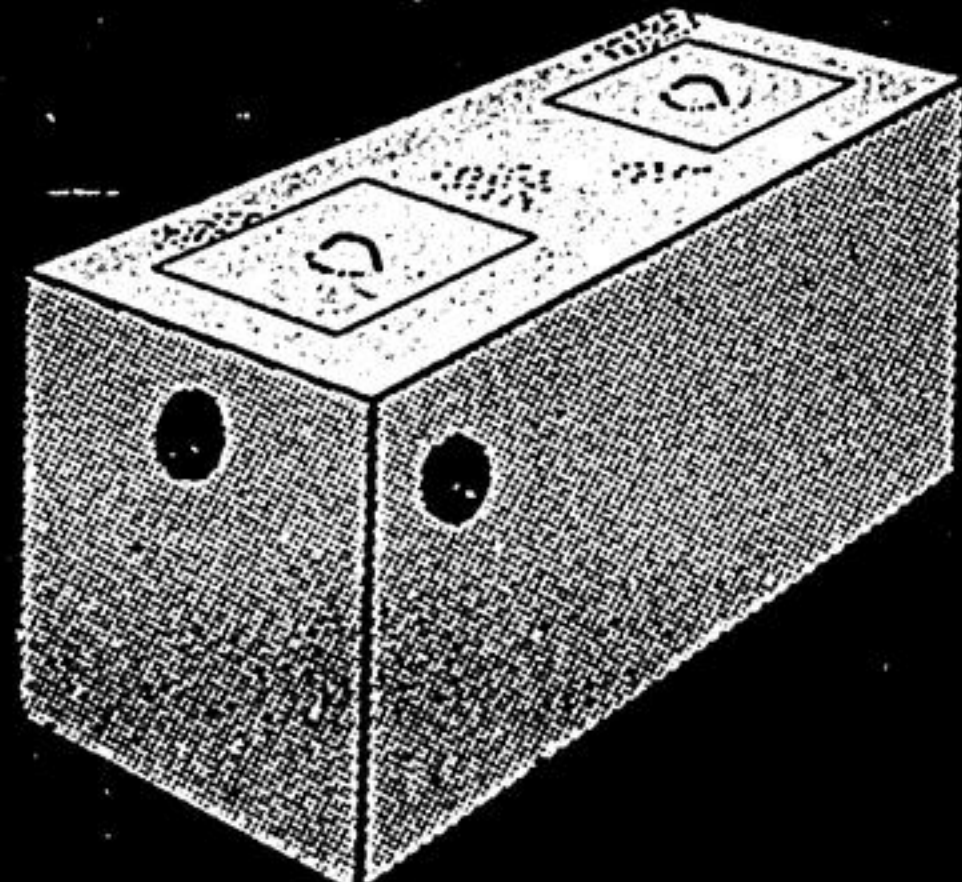
