Airport farms

PICKERING — Nothing's changed as far as the Pickering Airport site is concerned. The property's agricultural use will be continued for at least ten years and maybe longer, Transport Minister Don Mazaskowski told a meeting in Toronto, Monday.

The announcement is satisfying to Ontario Riding M.P. Scott Fennell. "My hard lobbying has paid off," he told The Tribune. "I don't think a second major airport has to be considered until the year 2,000."

The decision, Fennell says, makes it possible for recommendations by People or Planes in "The Last Green Door" brochure, to be implemented.

Farm land in north Pickering will be sterile no longer," he concluded.

MARKHAM — Ray Grant, R.R. 1, Stouffville, is the top corn-grower in the district.

All quiet at Kartways

GOODWOOD — All is quiet at Goodwood Kartways.

Ward one councillor John Paxton told The Tribune noise levels at the track are within acceptable levels, and he hasn't received any complaints from constituents.

He said major races are now held in Whitby, leaving the Goodwood kartway for use by the public.

Rolling Hills Golf club sold

BETHESDA — Rolling Hills, a golf estate that spreads over 260 acres of Whitechurch-Stouffville countryside, has been sold.

New owner is The Toronto Firefighters Club, an organization with elaborate headquarters on Esna Park Drive in Markham. Current membership totals about 1,500 with two golf courses. The other is Gormley Green, also in Whitechurch-Stouffville.

Harry Allard, the leading light at Rolling Hills for the past eighteen years, described the sale as "a tough and sad decision". One consolation is that the present staff will be retained, he said. The 400 club members will also be able to stay if they so wish.

For the present, at least, few changes are planned, Firefighters' President Jack McCall told The Tribune. The

operation will be year-round, however, with cross-country skiing encouraged during the winter. Snowmobiles will not be allowed.

A curling rink once operated at the site. This facility was later closed to permit extension to the banquet hall. Up to now, Rolling Hills is hosting about 275 tournaments per season.

The new executive will be comprised solely of firefighters and

operate on a semi-private arrangement as before. The public will be able to "pay-as-they-play" as will members' families and friends.

Rolling Hills' close proximity to Gormley Green makes it possible for the clubhouse to serve both courses, president McCall explained. "This solves our problem nicely," he said.
