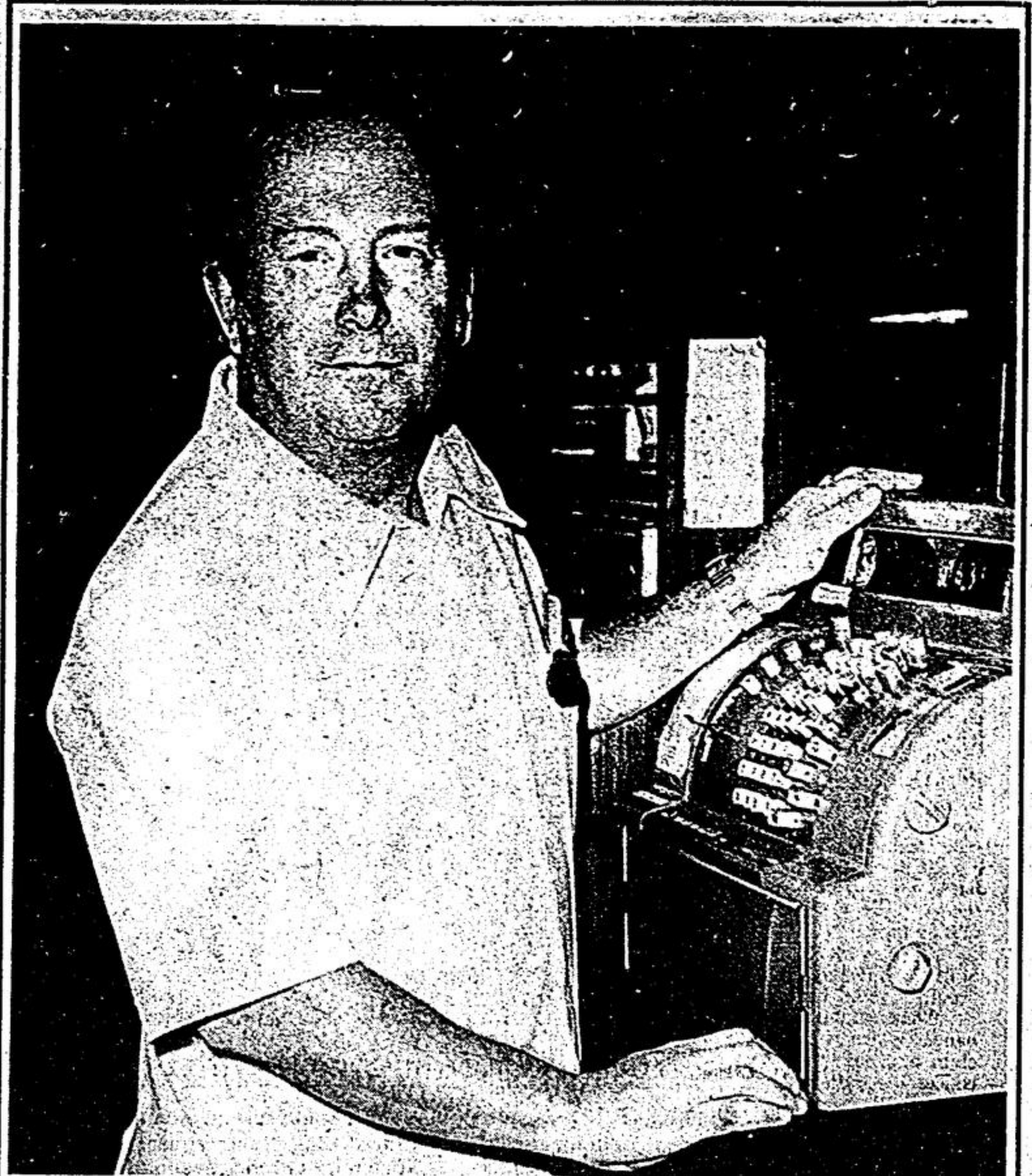

# Time to retire says druggist

STOUFFVILLE — A familiar face is missing from behind the prescription counter at Widdifield Drugs. John Houston, businessman here for most of twenty-seven years, has retired.

Or maybe just taking things a little easier, would be a better term. For, when he and wife Sybil move to Gravenhurst next spring, John says he may help out part-time at a drug store there. "I'd like to keep my hand in," he said, indicating he's not quite ready to sit back and put his feet up.

Nor should he; for he's every bit the personable, out-going guy that folks soon came to know as a friend way back in May, 1952. That was when he left the drug department at Eaton's and purchased Wes Boardway's Store at the corner of Church Street and Main. It became Houston's Pharmacy and still bears this name.

John Houston is a native of Alton, Ont., five miles south-west of Orangeville. During World War II, he served in the Canadian Army, then enrolled at Toronto University following his discharge. Before going to Eaton's, he did three years apprenticeship with G. Tamblin Limited.

It's been a rewarding career, he says, despite the fact he often received calls from customers at three and four o'clock in the morning. That was when he lived above the store.

John speaks highly of the profession

and the advancements made in the last quarter century. "We've come farther in the last 25 years than in the last 25,000," he said. The graduate druggist today, is extremely well educated, enabling him to talk on the same terms with a medical doctor.

In September, 1967, John sold out to Harry Bowes and went on to manage a store at Port Perry. Five and half years later, he was back in Stouffville and entered into a partnership with Doug Widdifield, Nov. 30, 1973. By coincidence, Doug was John's first pharmacist.

As an indicator of how times change, Widdifield's fill prescriptions for not just six physicians in Stouffville but 900 across Ontario. Prices have changed too.

"We think gas is high at \$1.10 a gallon," he said, "but a gallon of distilled water today is \$1.69."

John speaks with pride of his family that includes a son, Robert, assistant sales manager at Conlin Motors, Markham; two daughters, Patricia, a medical doctor, now working on a Fellowship at Toronto Western Hospital; Laurie, in second year Science at U. of T. and a beautiful granddaughter, Leah Houston in Pickering.

John's happy with his lot in life, the past, the present and hopefully the future. "Working on a one-to-one basis has given me great personal satisfaction and enjoyment," he admits, "I'd do it all over again."

## Theft spree

MARKHAM — A 17 year old youth has been remanded to Nov. 22 for sentence following conviction in Newmarket Court on two counts of break and entry in Markham and Metro areas; theft of \$577 from Country Style Donuts, Woodbine Avenue; theft of keys from Knob Hill Farms, Markham and failing to appear for trial.

Mark Fendley entered a plea of guilty to all charges before Judge F.D. White and has been placed in custody until his reappearance in a week's time.

According to evidence, Fendley stole a car from Conlin Motors, drove it to Barrie and abandoned it. At Buttonville, he broke into a garage, stole a motorbike and later abandoned it. The keys he took from Knob Hill Farms, he used to open pop machines at various locations.

The accused was described as a lad "with a miserable childhood." His parents had given him up when he was only two years old, the court was told.
