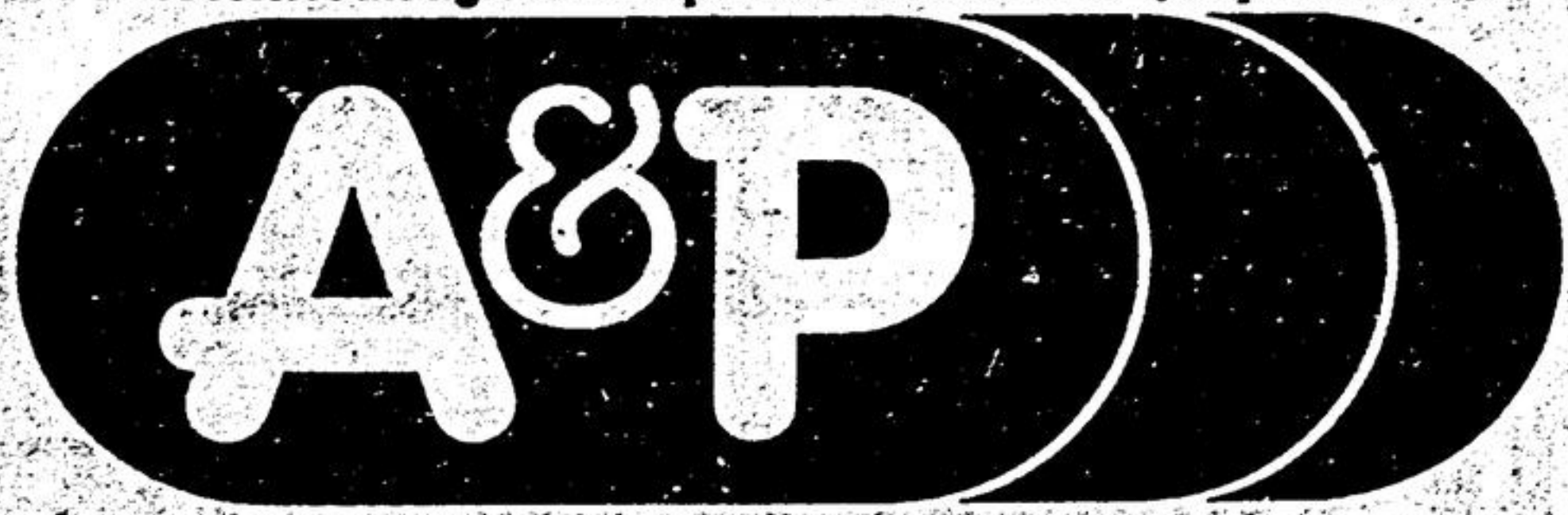

Fraud charges

STOUFFVILLE
Three persons have been charged with conspiracy to commit fraud after two men allegedly removed goods from the premises of Schell Lumber Ltd., Edward Street, Stouffville, then a woman took the merchandise back and received cash for the property.
The incident occurred shortly after 12 noon on Nov. 26. By 1:15 p.m., the trio was in custody of police, arrested on Yonge Street in Aurora.
Janice Lee Benedetti, 25, alias McAfee, alias Barratt, alias Walton of Rexdale; Myroslaw Hudyma, 47, alias Maurice Hudyma and Donald Joseph Gauthier, 27, both of Toronto, appeared in court, Nov. 27. Metro Toronto Police were holding warrants for the men prior to their arrest by York Region.

Alcohol problem

DURHAM REGION
Of 292 young people surveyed, 17 per cent had experienced alcohol induced blackouts, officials of Durham Region District Health Council representatives at regional high schools at meeting recently.
The objective is setting up of a Substance Abuse Advisory Committee. Its aim would be to engage teenagers to aid others who may have abuse problems.
Of the teen questioned, 13.4 per cent said they had felt the effects of alcohol while on the job or in school.
Many admitted they had been involved in public drunkenness fights and motor vehicle accidents.
Another meeting is planned in February when hopefully a student committee will be selected.

Refund policy

This year, after Christmas, many of us have returned to stores for refund. However, some customers may not realize that this request can be denied.
During the Christmas season, the time when you have available for thoughtful shopping is usually limited. Last minute buying may result in gifts which are not exactly what you wanted. But, you assume they can always be returned.
In fact, when you purchase anything, including a gift, you are entering a contract. You agree to exchange a given amount of money for a specific item. As with any contract, the sale cannot be cancelled without the agreement of both the buyer and the seller. Stores are not legally required to refund or exchange merchandise, unless it is defective or misrepresented.
Refund or exchange privileges are given voluntarily by the retailer and are often not advertised. To ensure that your friends or relatives are not left with a gift they can't use, ask before you buy.
