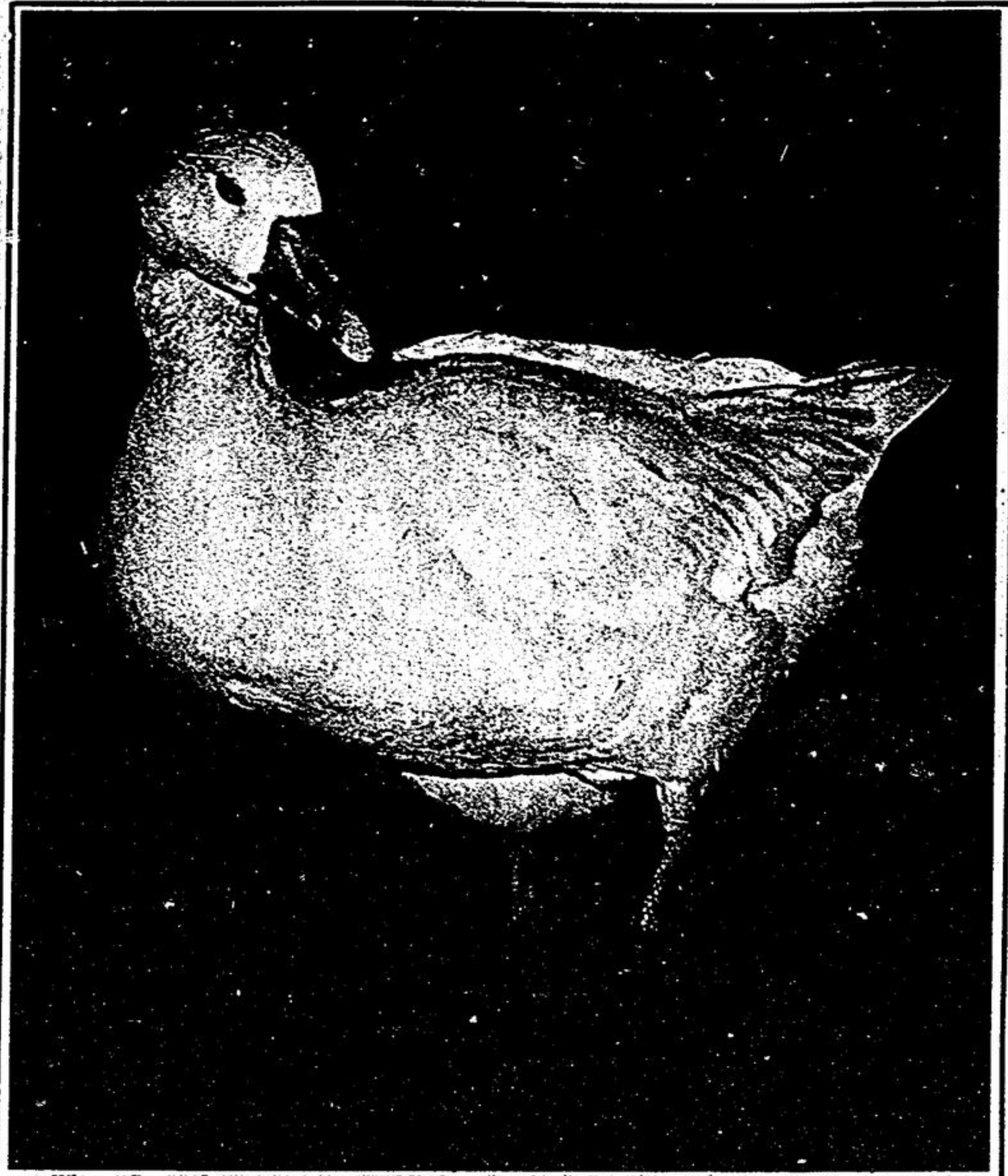

Prior to the operation, Ernie was advised as to cost. It would be expensive, the veterinarians said. They wondered if he might rather have her "put down". Ernie said no way and he's glad he did. For Gertrude's as right as rain with only a slight limp to remind her of the accident. The bill was something like two hundred dollars.

For many a goose, such an injury would have resulted in a one-way trip to the chopping block. But Ernie wanted no part of that. He transported her to the Stouffville Veterinary Clinic where a steel pin was inserted.

All the attention she received created a "break" in the family circle. Her brothers and sisters were miffed and flatly refused to let her join them in formation flights. "It was sad," Ernie said, "the others soaring aloft while Gertie was left all on her own".

The surgery was successful and Gertrude was soon mobile. But her convalescence required more than just getting back on her feet. She had to learn to swim,

While snubbed "up above", Gertrude is "queen of her court" on the ground. She waddles over from the barn and pecks at the back door to be let in.

The affection she shows for her master is touching. When Ernie feeds her pieces of bread, she snuggles up to him and caresses his cheek.

Ernie says Gertrude will limp as long as she lives. But apart from this, she'll lead a perfectly normal life.

## Brownsberger Families September reunion

VIC. SQUARE — On Sat., Sept. 27, Brownsberger families from all across the country including some from the United States, will attend a reunion at the Community Centre in Victoria Square.

The get-together, held every five years, honors the memory of George and Elizabeth Brownsberger who emigrated from Manheim, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and settled with their six children, north of Ringwood in 1826. One son, Jacob, died at the age of sixteen and a daughter, Catherine died at age eleven. Those who survived included - daughters Nancy (Mrs. Chris Musselman); Veronica (Mrs. Samuel Reesor) and sons Benjamin who married Mary Davis and Samuel who married Fanny Burkholder.

Florence Yakeley of Stouffville, author of a book on the Brownsberger family in Canada and the United States, told The Tribune that contact had been made with two families in the U.S., "who we had only heard about through stories". She's hopeful some may be able to make the trip here this fall. She's also anxious to keep the family history up to date through supplementary sheets.
