Annual report

STOUFFVILLE — Membership at the United Church remained stable during the year.
In the annual report, the figures as of Dec. 31, 1979 were 382 resident and non-resident members, as compared to 378 the same time last year.
There were 20 baptisms, 21 weddings, and 12 funerals throughout the year. There were twelve new members received, and three left by transfer and five by death.

Program
STOUFFVILLE — The Memorial Christian Church invites people of all ages to attend their Sunday School program beginning at 9:45 a.m. The theme is "God's Own People: The Church". This theme continues every Sunday until the middle of Feb. Rev. Jacob Small emphasizes that adults should attend this program.

The UCW proposed budget for 1980 is \$3,970, up from last year's figure of \$3,880.
Assets in the trustee account as of Dec. 31, 1979 were \$60,227.98, and total assets in the manse account were \$41,877.48.
Operating expenses including fuel, supplies, hydro and water, and insurance for the year were \$14,520.58, as compared to \$10,886.84 in 1978.
Total disbursements as of Sept. 31, 1979 were \$73,942.08. In 1978 the figures were \$64,465.64.
