

Gains Tax unfair

Dear Mr. Thomas: Although most Canadians speak the same language, this in no way implies the same understanding. Words can be used to serve the user's purpose. Take, for example, the word "infringed". If one infringes upon a right, one hampers its free exercise and maybe even prevents its exercise entirely.

Like the administration of Capital Gains Tax. There's no advance ruling how we are served in this law or how much we are forced to pay — truly a process of administration in the "dark".

In many instances, the personnel of Revenue Canada is neither trained, qualified or properly licenced to make appraisals. Rest assured, you always get the short end of the stick.

Capital Gains Tax is most unfair. It kills initiative. It's double taxation and criminal.

Remember, the Indians do the scalping but the chiefs supply the knives.

If you have doubts concerning the legal status of your appraisal, contact The Appraisal Institute of Canada, Ontario Association, 5468 Dundas Street West, Toronto or The Appraisal Institute of Canada, Toronto Chapter, 8 Colborne Street, Toronto. Have it verified. If it's a fraud, then lay charges.

The Attorney General should order an investigation into all past cases and if wrongs have been committed, the money falsely collected since Dec. 31, 1971, should be returned.
