Little Nicole Will of Toronto spent several days with her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Meredith Ash.

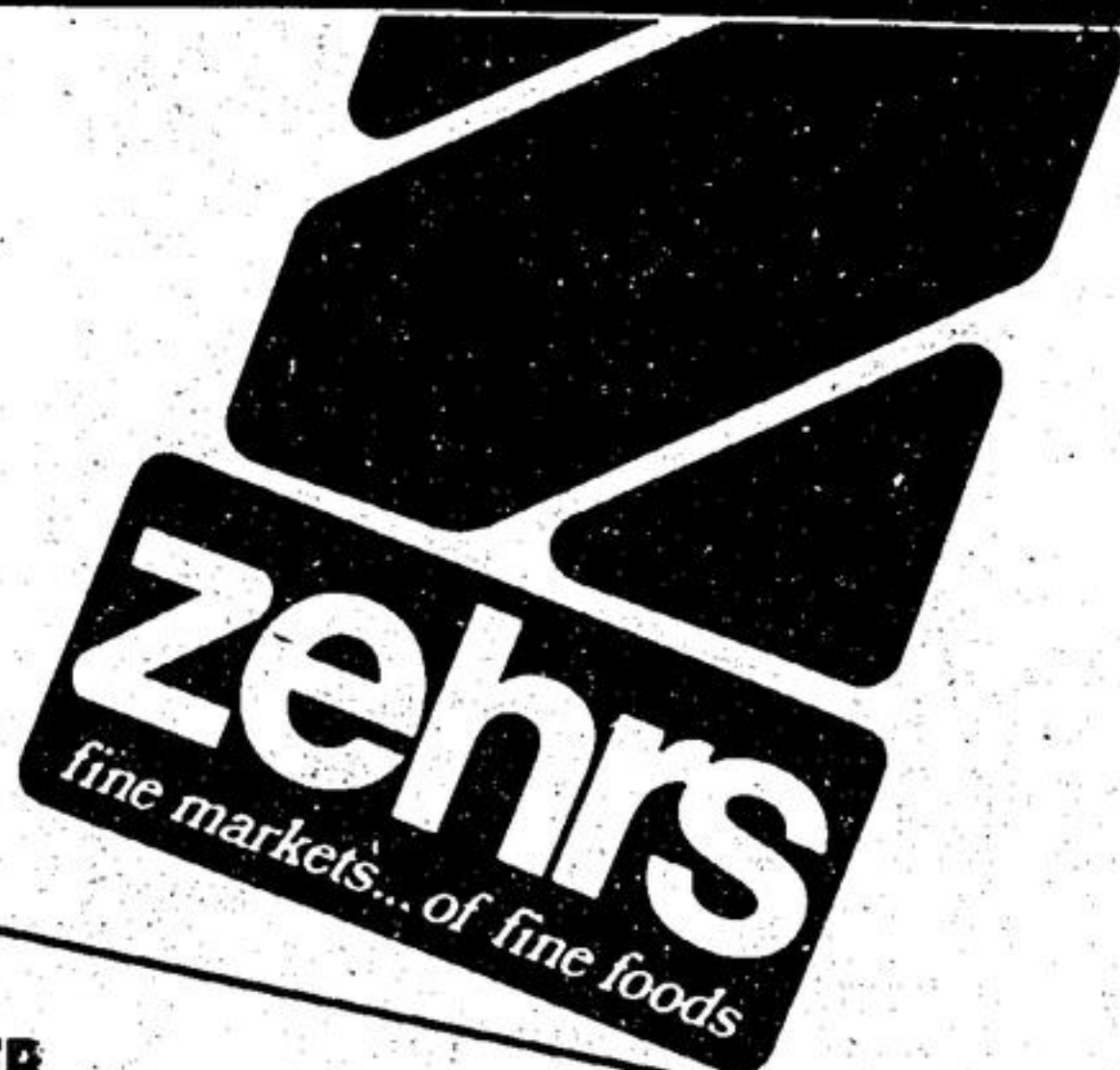

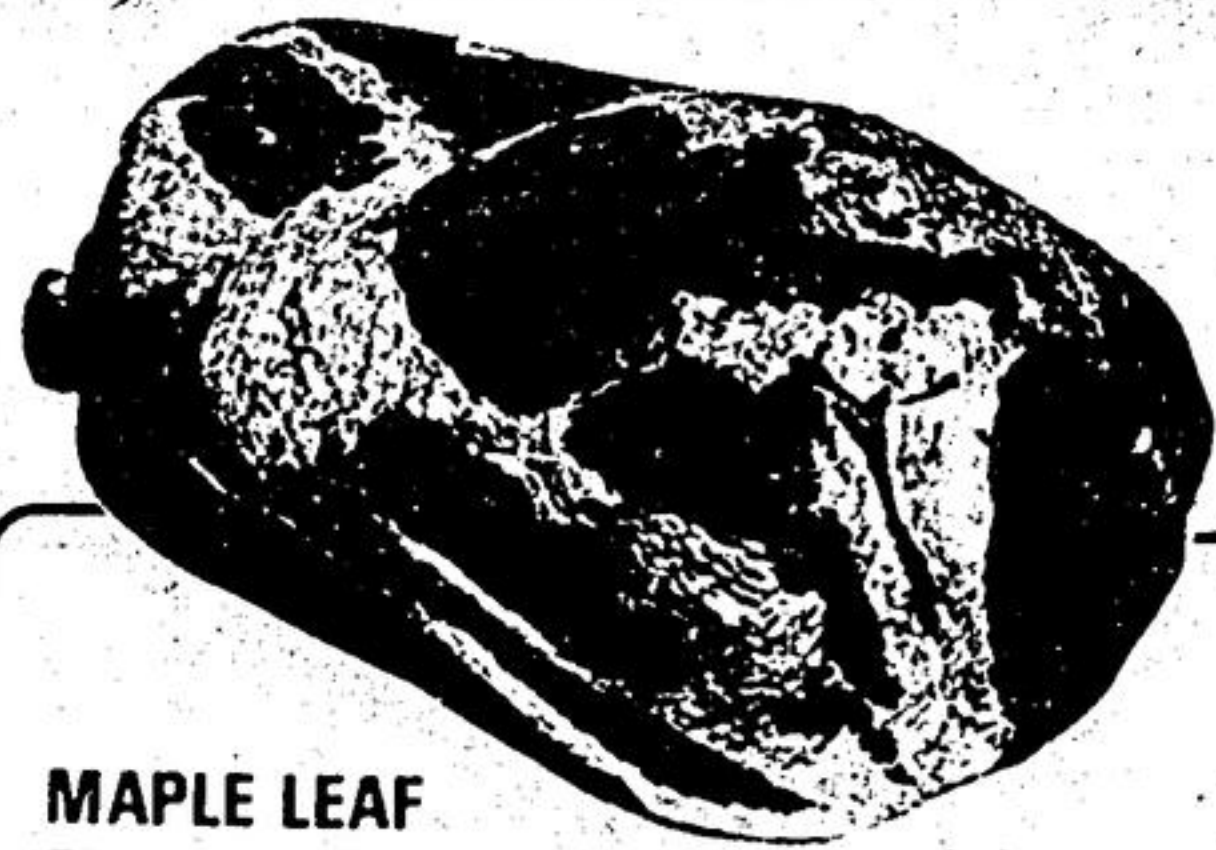

DEVILLED PORK CHOPS

- 6 pork chops
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 3 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 6 tablespoons chili sauce or catsup

2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce. Remove most of the fat from the chops. Soak the chops 1 hour in a marinating mixture made of the remaining ingredients.

Melt and brown the fat in a frying pan. Drain the chops and brown in the melted fat. When browned, add the marinating mixture.

Cover the frying pan and simmer over low heat 1 hour. The chops cooked in this manner are delicious with spinach and mashed potatoes.
