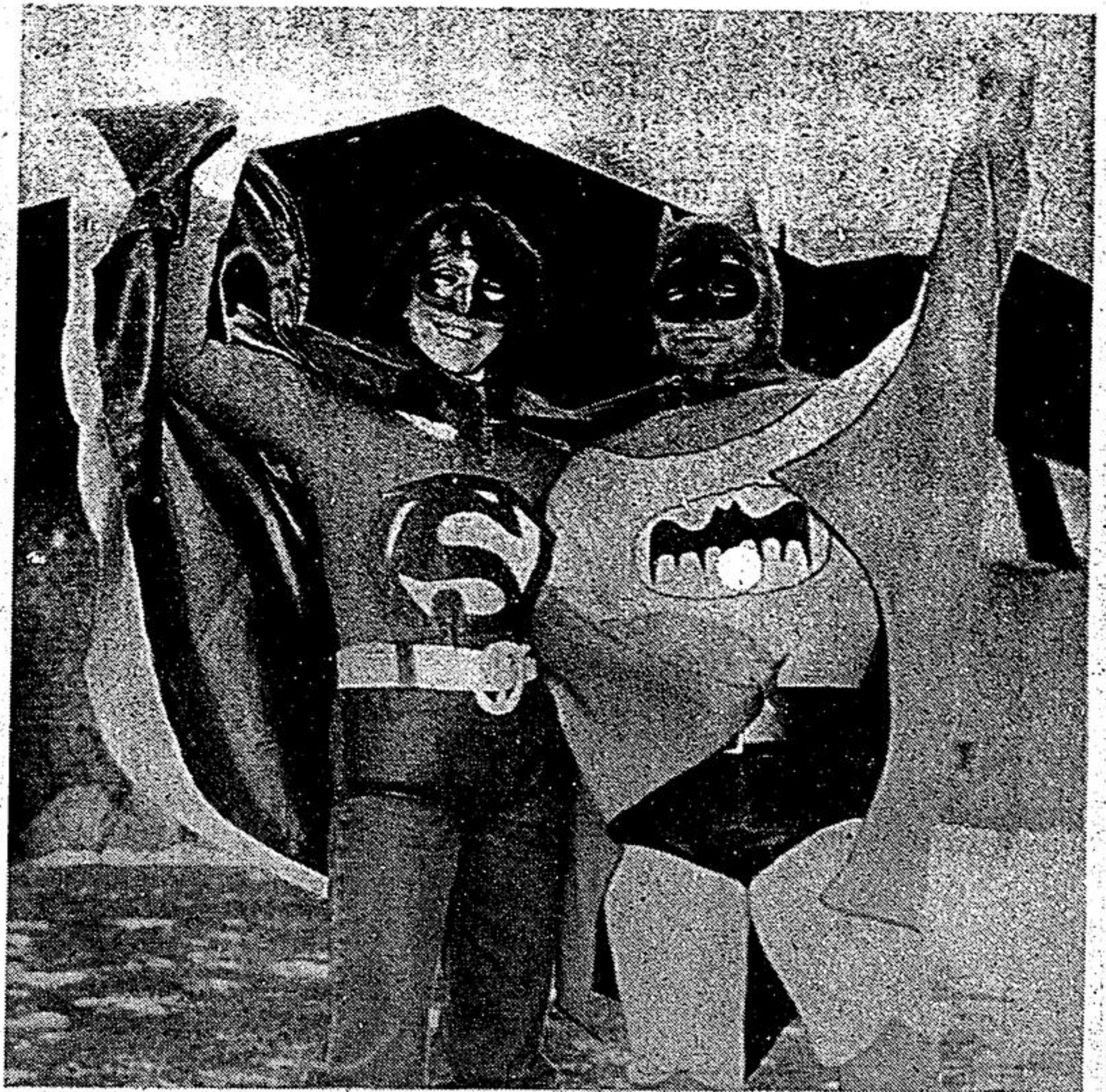


Town parade had variety
