

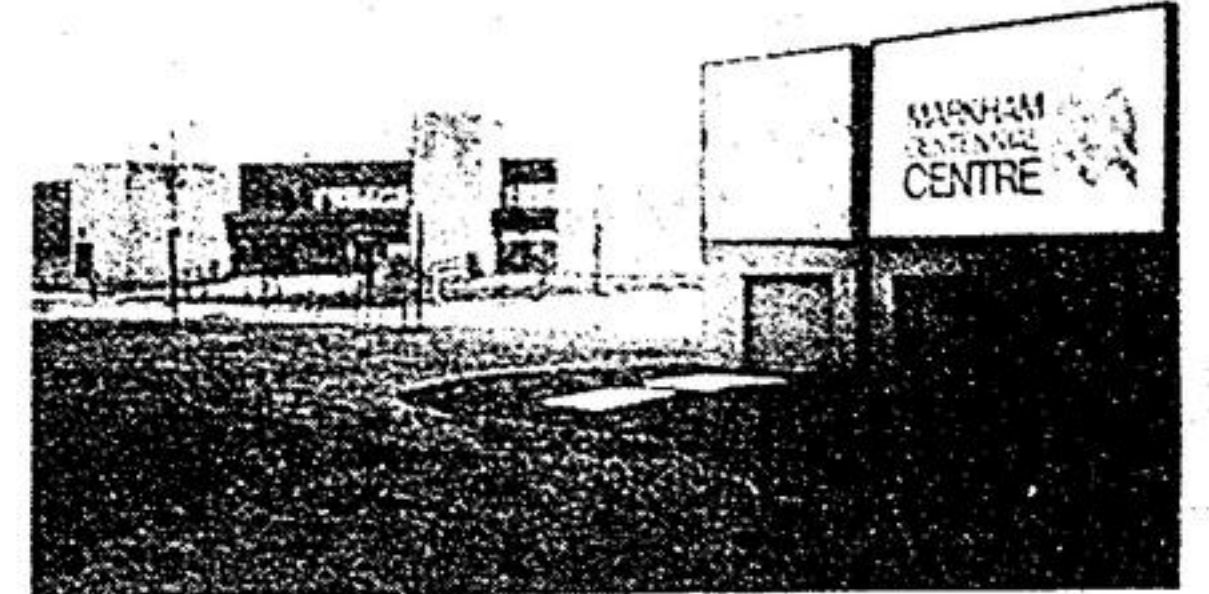

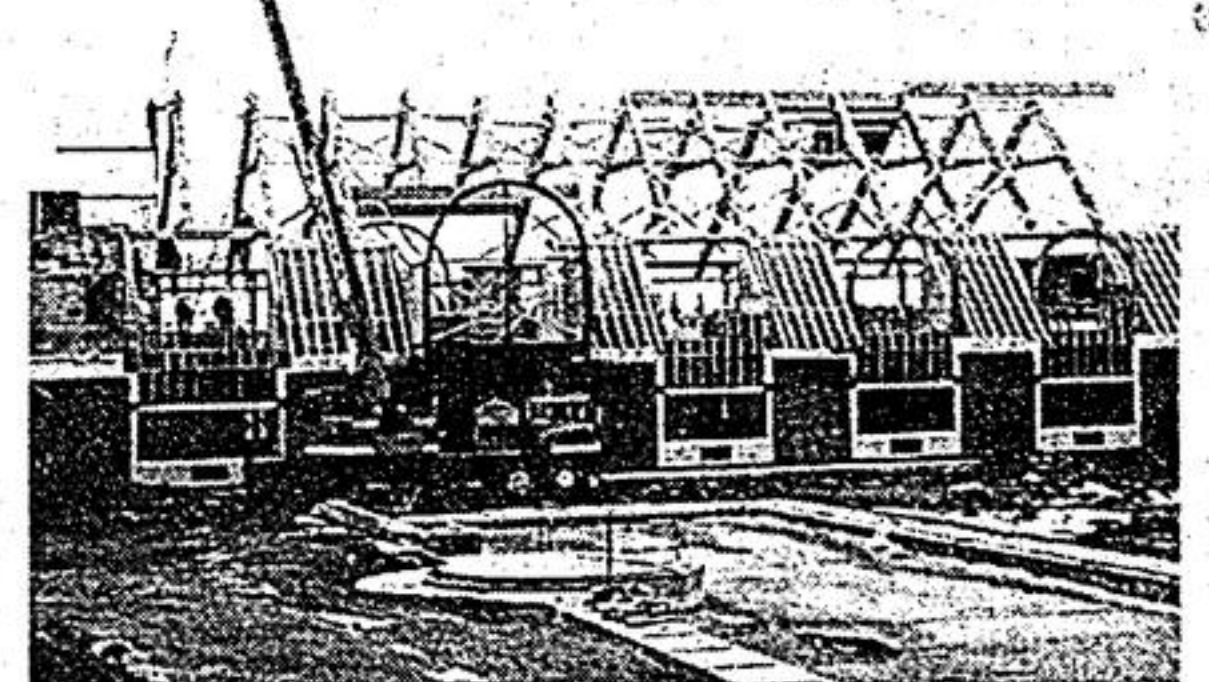

Official Plan monitoring policies have been accepted to control the desired assessment ratio between Industrial, Commercial and Residential to ensure the continuance of existing economical tax rates.

Markham provides suburban living at its best. Excellent recreation facilities include modern arenas and fitness centres, swimming pools, golf courses and numerous delightful parks.

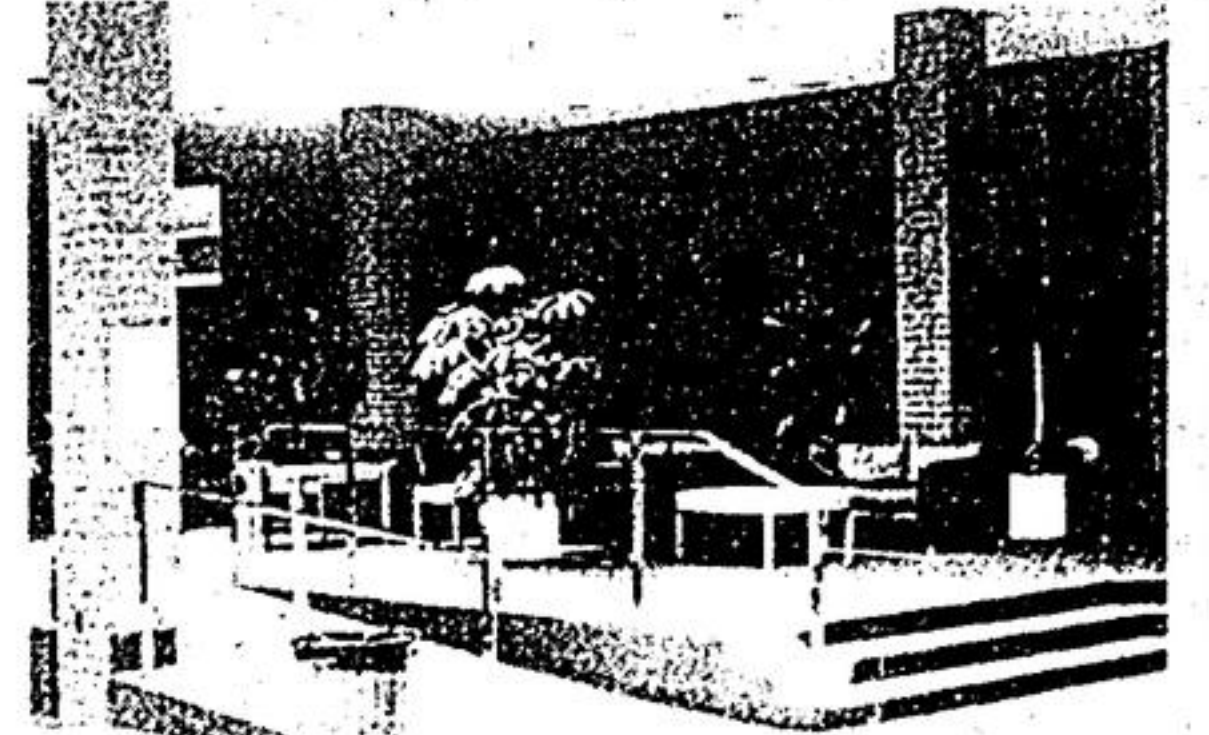
