At one time Janice seriously considered a career in modelling. Now, she's happy everything worked out the way it did.

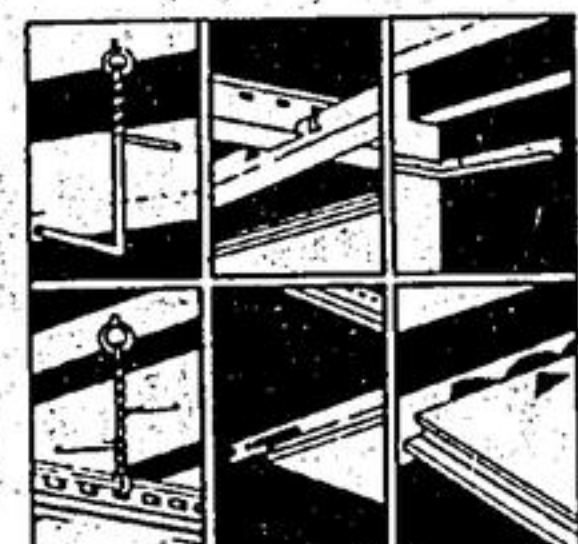


Nineteen year old Janice Canavan of Goodwood will be seeking a medical secretary's position following graduation from Centennial College this spring.

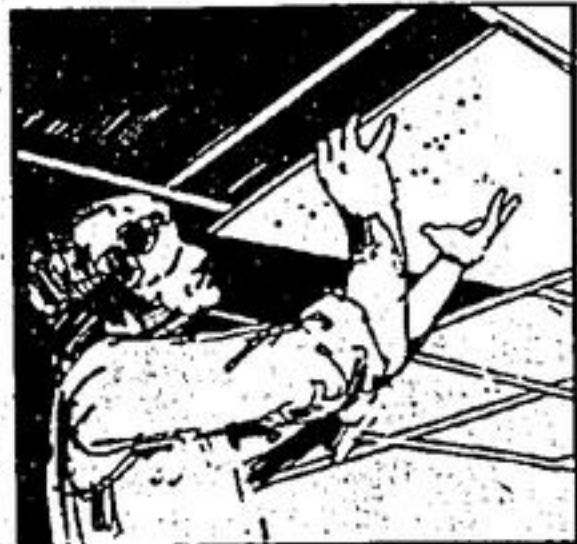

A suspended ceiling system can improve any room that has unsightly wiring or plumbing. Metal components push up and lock together to form a 2' x 4' grid system.

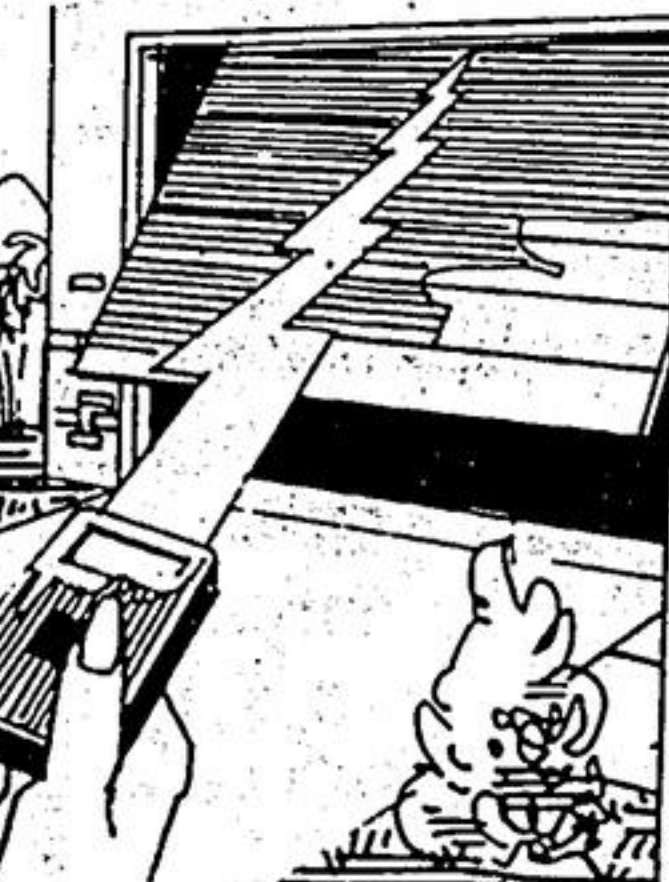

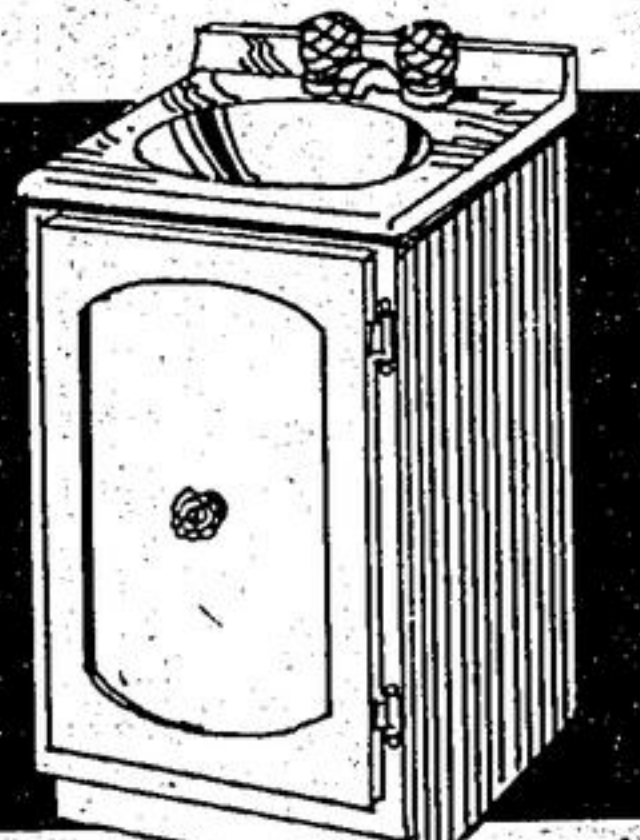

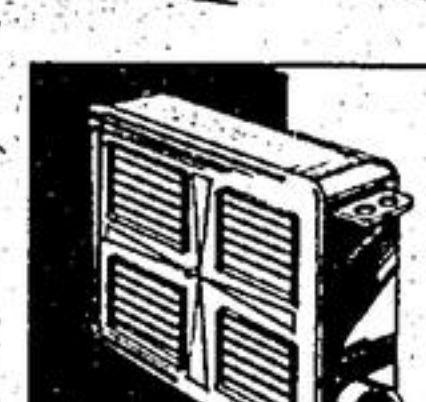

STOUFFVILLE — Despite the fact Stouffville United Church went half the year without a permanent pastor and the town experienced little residential growth, membership in the congregation (both resident and non-resident) stood at 390 as of Dec. 31, 1980. This is five more than at the same period in '79.

The annual meeting was held following the morning service, Jan. 25.

son, R.R. 2, Markham (Jan. 23); Peter Bennett, R.R. 1, Gormley (Feb. 15); Marion Fleury, Parkview Apartments (Feb. 18); Clarke Hoover, Church Street North (March 12); Lillas Kiloh, Stouffville Nursing Home (March 27); Harold Thompson, York County Hospital (March 1); Albert Wesley Slack, Parkview Home (March 27); Isabella Slack, Parkview Home (April 21); Fred Nicely, R.R. 4 Stouffville (May 7); Walter Gauslin, Stouffville (May 28); Freda Emmerson, Parkview Home (May 20); Margaret Gordon, Stouffville (June 4); Robert Rawson, Hawthorne Avenue (June 10); Hal Keating, Newmarket (June 22); and Mary Hazel Winn, Parkview Home (Aug. 5).

The past year was an eventful one for the

congregation, twelve months filled with mixed emotions. The church's pastor, Rev. Jim Carder retired at the end of June and was honored at a luncheon on the 22nd of that month. In September, the hiring of a successor to Mr. Carder was recommended by the Pastoral Relations Committee and approved. Rev. Cecil Tiller of St. Andrew's United Church, Regina Saskatchewan began his ministry here in January.

The United Church, under the leadership of Dr. Bill Murphy, joined with the Anglican and Presbyterian Churches, and conducted a town visitation over a three-week period in June.

Total receipts in 1980 were \$78,037.92. The prepared budget for 1981 estimated receipts at \$91,603 and expenditures at \$92,703.00.

Notices with detailed procedures for individual public schools have been sent home with present pupils. Parents or guardians who have not received such notices are requested to contact the school serving their area or the appropriate Board office.

- Area No. 4 Markham (and Thornhill Public School in Vaughan) 884-2098, 887-5451

PLEASE NOTE:

- Parents or guardians must be public school supporters.
- To be eligible for admission in September 1981 children must have been born on or before December 31, 1976. Verification of birthdate and record of immunization are required. Application forms for birth certificates are available in the schools.
- If a school receives more registrations than it can accommodate, all registrations received before May 1st will be treated equally as far as date of registration is concerned. Registrations received on or after May 1st will be sequenced and the date of registrations will be the criteria used to determine which pupils may be required to attend another school unless there are sufficient volunteers to do so.
