Dear Jim:

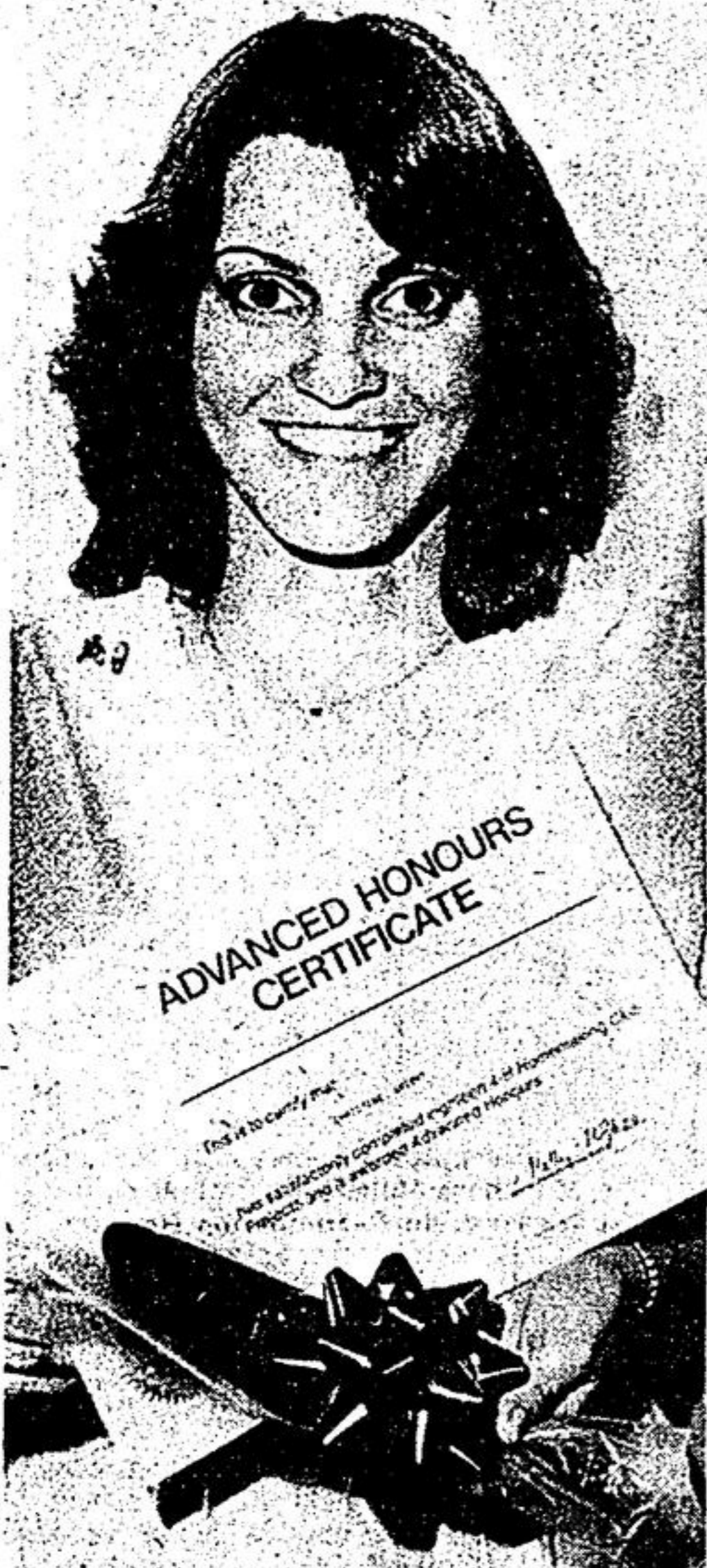
