TAKE NOTICE that an environmental assessment for the above undertaking has been received from the Minister of Transportation and Communications and a review has been prepared by Ontario Government Ministries and agencies.

The review is intended to assist the public in its consideration of the environmental assessment and the undertaking. The review represents only a preliminary position based on the comments of the staff of the Provincial Ministries and agencies involved in the review. It does not represent a deci

The review of the environmental assessment recommends

that the environmental assessment be accepted as satisfac-

tory basis for making a decision on whether the undertaking should proceed and the undertaking be given approval to proceed subject to conditions. A copy of the environmental assessment and the review may be inspected in the full Public Record during normal

Under the Act, consideration must now be given as to the acceptance of the assessment and whether approval to proceed with the undertaking should or should not be given and, if given, whether the approval should be subject to any con-

Before these matters are considered, any person may make a written submission with regard to the undertaking, the environmental assessment and the review thereof and may also require a hearing by the Environmental Assessment Board. The submission and/or hearing requirement should be sent by registered mail or delivered to me at the address below. A submission may be made in any form that clearly indicates the purpose of the document. The Regulation under the Act provides a form which may be used for a submission, but use of the form is not mandatory.

Any submission or requirement should be received by me no later than May 17th, 1981.

Only those persons who make written submissions or require a hearing or otherwise advise me, will be placed on the mailing list for subsequent notices or orders.
