## Hydro Office

MARKHAM — Markham Hydro Chairman, Alma Walker, announced tenders were called June 22, 1981 for site services at the new Commission Headquarters on Warden Avenue.

The new building will incorporate all Commission facilities into one location and is to be situated on 33 acres of surplus government land on Warden at the proposed Highway 407 interchange.

The site selection was confirmed following negotiations with Ministry of Government Services, Ministry of Housing and Ministry of Transport officials. Before the land purchase could be finalized at a fraction of the current real estate market value, Metropolitan Toronto Region Conservation Authority, Region of York and Town of Markham requirements had to be satisfied.

Architect Ted Sievenpiper has been working with Commission and staff for over a year in planning the new facility.
