

Rivals no match for Ryan

CLAREMONT — Four victories and 42 strike-outs in a single day. That was hurler Bob Ryan's record in pitching the Claremont Legion 'Blues' to the All-Ontario Bantam "D" Championship.

"When you're hot, you're hot," commented manager Frank Hendy in describing Ryan's superb performance. He issued only three walks.

Two of the four games were shut-outs. Claremont blanked Lansdowne 8-0 in the first contest and wiped out Mary Hill 7-0 in the third. They whipped Port Stanley twice, 8-3 and 12-1.

"Our boys played super ball," said Hendy. While Ryan was "mowing them down at the plate", Claremont was displaying good power with their bats. They also performed well defensively, he said.

The management and players will be honored at a season-end banquet in the fall. No date has been set.

Claremont's clean-up slugger, Scott Harper had a field day at the expense of rival pitchers, hitting nine for fourteen. Mark Hendy also had a great day, connecting for eight safeties in twelve trips. Three of his blasts were two-run homers including a pair of round-trippers against Port Stanley.
