Son mistreated claim parents

UNIONVILLE — A complaint by a Unionville couple about police procedures involving the arrest of their son, will be studied by the York Regional Police Commission after the charges laid against the youth have been dealt with in court.

In a letter to the Board received this week, Mr. and Mrs. Horace Gentes say that police action taken against their son during an incident which occurred at the Unionville Festival last June, was "unjust and uncalled for."

The Unionville couple claim their son Ken was unjustly accused of vandalism. The Gentes say Ken, in fact, had gone to the area to try and stop a fight which had broken out among other youths. The couple claim a York Regional police officer

put a night stick around their son's throat and started strangling him.

The Gentes in their letter to the Board are requesting the conduct of the officer be investigated and the Board launch an investigation into the ratio of arrest and assault charges against the constable.

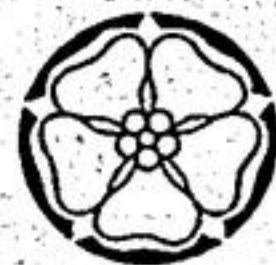

YORK REGION — Jail sentences rather than fines await motorists convicted of impaired driving, Provincial Court Judge Russell G. Pearce warned last week.
