

Reluctant witness

To marry accused

YORK REGION: Back in August, Eugenia Geneau, then of Thornhill, pressed charges of common assault and unlawful confinement against Donald Bone, a 29 year old York Regional Police constable.

Last week in Newmarket Provincial Court, Miss Geneau told Judge C.W. Guest "I don't feel I should testify

against the man I'm going to marry." The charges were subsequently dismissed. Constable Bone had entered pleas of not guilty.

It was the same woman who, three months earlier had gone to a York Regional crown attorney with a story about being held captive in the officer's apartment nearly six hours. She said Bone had forced her into an elevator and then into his residence after accusing her of seeing another man.

In court, however, she claimed the constable had only "nudged" and "pushed" her a bit. She denied she'd been hurt. The woman admitted, however, that a torn shirt and bra, produced as exhibits, had been worn by her on the night of the incident. She also said she'd been "kicked a few times" but the constable was only in his sock feet. She also claimed she'd been "hit a few times with pillows" and had been poured over her.

She claimed her fiancé had acted out of feelings of frustration. She said she had never wanted criminal charges laid against the accused and "I made things sound worse than they were."

Supt. John Taylor told the court he first met Geneau in the company of Inspectors Smyth and Hill and warned her of the

seriousness of her allegations. He told her also, he said, that if an investigation was started, it would be carried through to a conclusion.

The superintendent said the complainant didn't want the incident "swept under the rug" just because Bone happened to be a police officer.

Geneau, in her testimony, admitted to drinking heavily on the night in question.

David Hobson, solicitor for Bone described the fracas as "a lovers' quarrel" - "a bizarre inane case to come before the court."

A thrown pillow, sock-foot kick and some spilled beer could be

considered an act of assault.

Judge Guest said he was certain no jury would bring in a finding of guilty in such a case. He noted that the girl's initial statement and her evidence under oath were "totally different." He said the turn-about could be sufficient to charge the woman with public mischief.

Constable Bone still faces a charge of creditable conduct under the Police Act. He had previously pleaded guilty to a charge of negligence of duty has been withdrawn.

Bone has been suspended from duties since August but is still receiving full pay.
