STOUFFVILLE — The congregation of Stouffville Baptist Church has a new pastor, Harley Winborn, a graduate of Ontario Bible College and a staff member with World Vision of Canada begins a full-time ministry here Jan. 24. He and wife Mary, now residents of Toronto, hope to make Stouffville their home when accommodation becomes available.
