Life savers

STOUFFVILLE — An emergency first aid course will be conducted this month and next at Stouffville Dist. Secondary School.

Instruction will be divided into these classes: (1) Emergency Medical Care, March 4, 11, 18 and April 1 from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. (2) Heart Saver Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation, March 15 and 16; March 29 and 30 from 7:30 to 10:30 p.m. (3) Basic Rescue

Emergency Medical Care is an eight-hour introductory first aid course that includes artificial

resuscitation of adults and children. Heart Saver, C.P.R. provides instructions for those persons who may be the first to arrive at a drowning, an electrocution or heart attack scenes.

Basic Rescue C.P.R. is appropriate for those who, through their positions, might be

exposed to rescue situations such as police, firefighters, safety foremen, ambulance personnel or child care workers.

Each program is recognized and certified by the Canadian Heart Foundation.

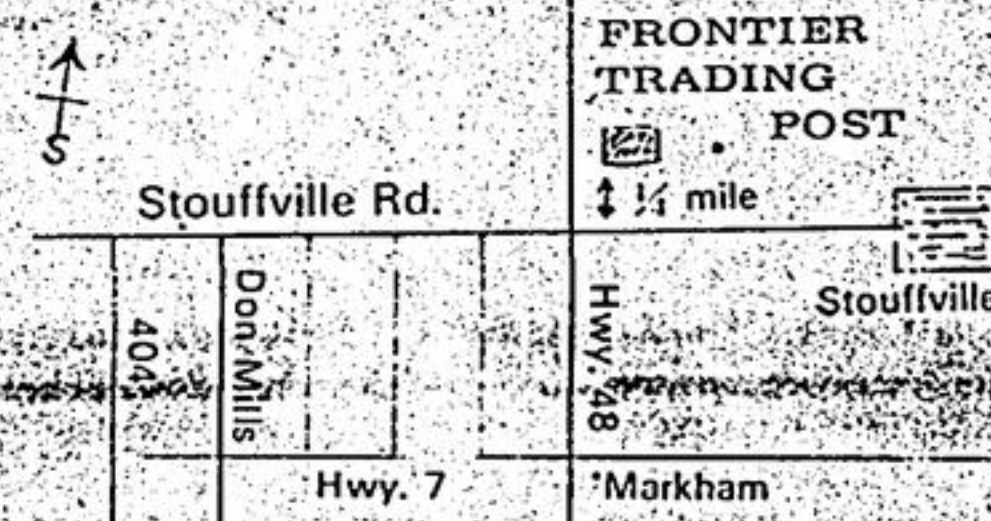
