And pacer is definitely the word for Cam Fella who has a habit of setting the pace; in a recent race he led all the way, an unusual happening in that form of competition.

However, just to make things even more exciting, Norm Faulkner and his partner have another pacer, De Santis, a four-year-old, who hangs back in the pack, saving his bursts to the front just before the wire.

The four-year-old is at stud near Uzbridge at the moment, but will be back soon. In the meantime, Cam Fella reads for the next one. Only this time he'll be breaking fast.

One spill is enough; besides he's more at home in front of the pack.
