## That's a promise! Clean junk

STOUFFVILLE—An antique dealer applying to council for a permit to build here, last week said his stock included some junk, but it was "clean junk."

The same applied to his garbage, John Riordan, Gormley, told the meeting.

Riordan, who operated an antique flea market in Weston, said he wished to rezone his property on Lot 3, Woodbine Ave., to accommodate a residence, and for commercial and industrial uses. The latter would include prospective clients, Proact Plastic of Canada, Action Communication Publishers, and Jack Bird Plumbing Co.

"Our intentions are to build a building... having a ground area of from 12,000 to 15,000 square feet, for our family business," Riordan said in a letter to council.

"...We want a clean

type of company and will be restrictive on who we will accept," he wrote. He told council he sold "antiques, crafts and a little bit of junk."

Of his 90 acres of land, 80 had little top soil, because they had been used for sod farming for several years, he said. The proposed zoning had been arranged so that no commercial or industrial zoning would border on the neighboring Heise Hill Church.

Riordan said his market would be open only on week-ends. He said, also, he had looked for locations throughout the area, but had been unable to come up with a suitable one.

Mayor Eldred King said that any rezoning would require an amendment to the official plan.

On a motion by Councillor Wilf Morley, the matter was referred to the town planning consultant and the Highway 404 corridor study.

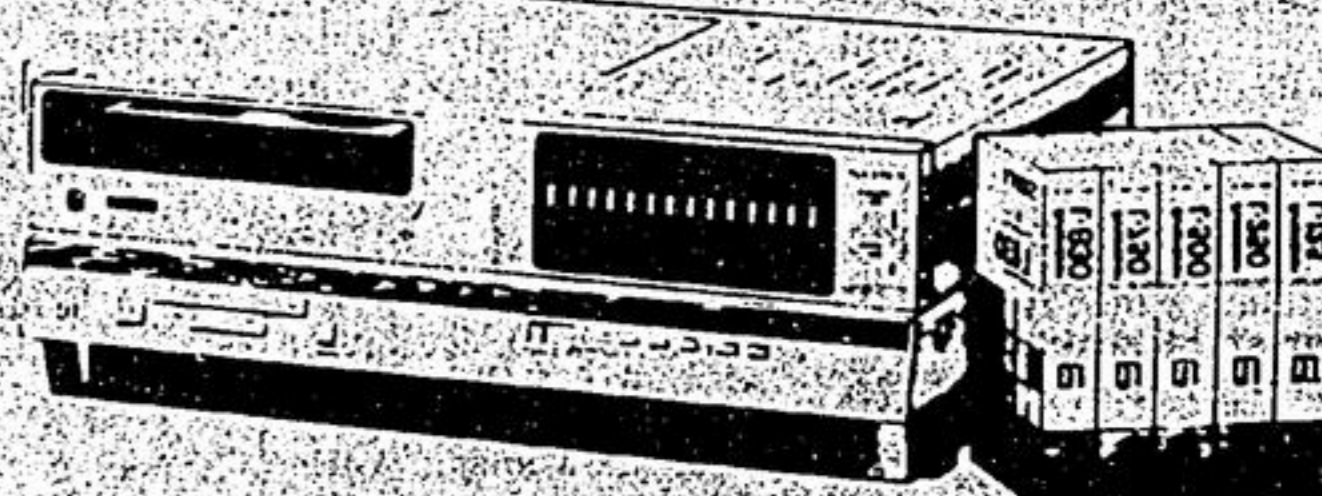
