Ron Dancey — Stands pat Heaps praise on mayor

MARKHAM - York Regional Councillor, Ron Dancey, "crossed up" a press conference, Thursday, when he told those on hand he wouldn't be running for mayor.

The session at Fernando's Restaurant had been prepared to take down the formal announcement of Dancey's intentions that way, and he even admitted that "the hype seems to be that I'm going to run for mayor".

While there was "some reason for that

"As long as Tony's (Mayor Tony Roman) there, (he and I think alike), I see no reason to change for change's sake," Dancey said.

"I've supported Tony in most cases, and when you have a good team pulling together, you should keep it pulling together. Tony's always supported me in my endeavors," he said.

"I intend to run again as a regional councillor," Dancey continued, listing some of things he hoped

could be accomplished.

These include a hospital, a theatre, a fire hall, a sports complex and a new municipal building. The latter "could become a focal point—the Town needs a new municipal office," he stressed.

Dancey said he'd also like to see a new police building in Markham and new regional headquarters in Newmarket.

"As a small businessman, used to stretching the dollar a

long way, I say we need more businessmen on council," he said.

When asked if he would favor a salary increase if one was proposed, Dancey said that, while he believed the councillors have the right to increase their own stipends, he would vote against it.

Should council get involved with school costs, as suggested by a Georgina Township councillor? Dancey replied "no comment," but added "trustees should seek ways to bring costs down."
