

### A mansion

STOUFFVILLE - A large house, under construction on the Whitechurch-Stouffville-Uxbridge townline, that has caught the eye of many motorists, will be occupied by a Scarborough couple.

The two-storey, red brick home, is expected to be completed within two months. Work on it began in May.

The four-bedroom, 3,600 square-foot residence is located on a 45 acre property.

## Closes doors

STOUFFVILLE - After just over two years, Jake's Jeans, 27 Main Street East, has sold its last pair of denims.

Owner Rick Ashton, closed the doors Friday, after a week-long sell-out sale, which, he said, brought in almost as much as he'd made in the past year.

"If I could have had an opening-day sale and a closing-day sale every 12 months, I'd have been alright," Ashton told The Tribune.

The young owner said that, while the business was "still profitable," the over-all work involved in keeping it going, didn't make it worthwhile.

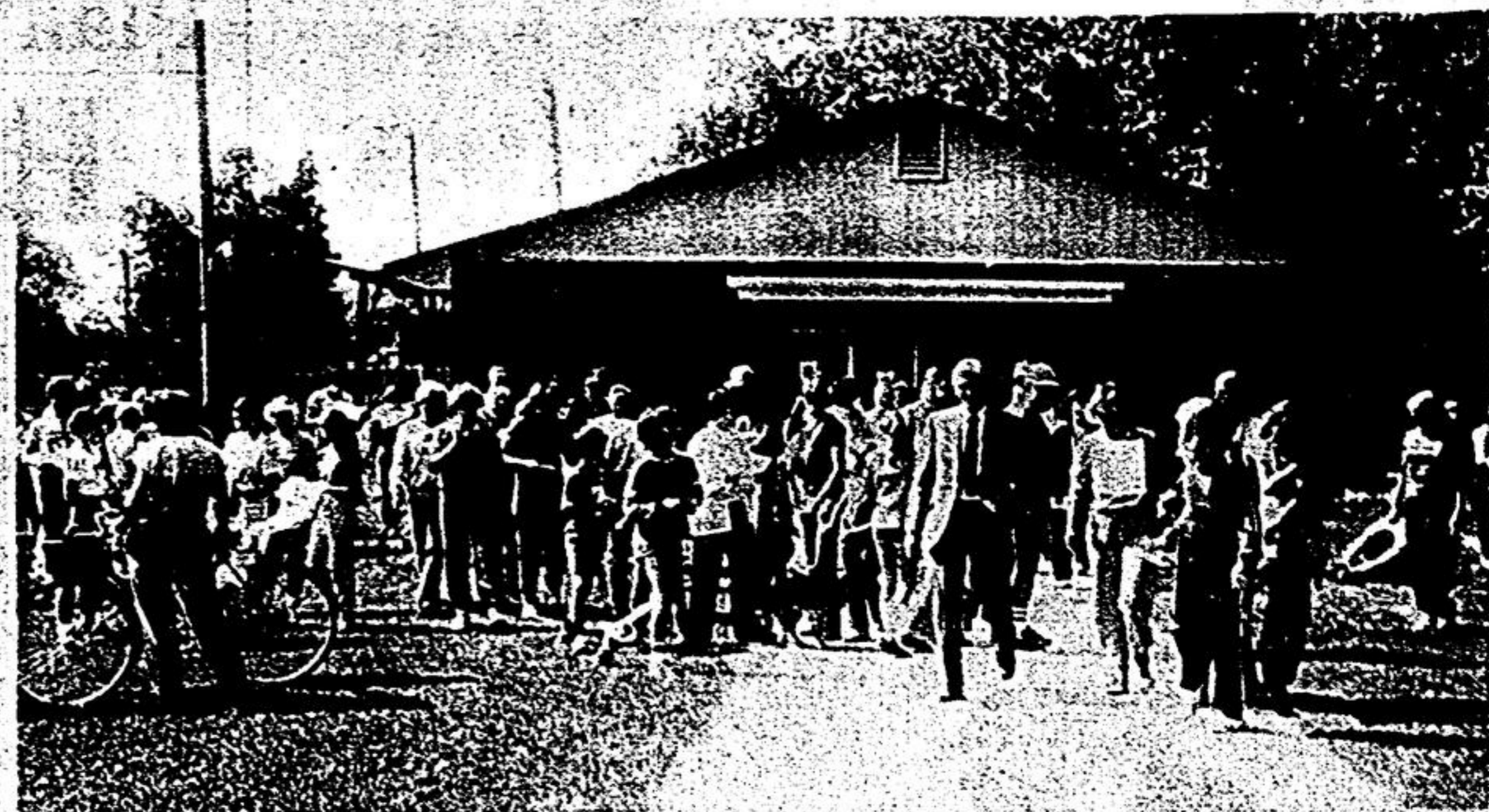
Ashton said too, that last year's robbery, in which much of his stock was taken, hurt him badly. Even though the insurance covered it, he hadn't been able to make up the business lost.

Ashton also had some criticism for the town as a whole. It's a "dormitory town," he said, one in which people spend much of their time and money in the city. The operating hours here, make it difficult for people to shop when they want.

He said he didn't want his remarks to be taken as "sour grapes," but he found that local organizations didn't support their local merchants, citing a case in which one group went to Toronto to buy several hundred T-shirts.

"I can understand losing business to another businessman in town, but not to Metro," said Ashton, who added that his own prices had always been kept low.

He said that, following the windup of his business, he may work as an ambulance dispatcher in Metro. While the pressures may be greater, it'll be better than "doing cross-word puzzles all day."

STOUFFVILLE - Crying foul about fowl, near a proposed housing development, isn't much of an argument as far as Mayor Eldred King is concerned.

Mayor King told Brian Whitehead, spokesman for a 70-unit development north of King Cole Duck Farms, that "occasional odors" from the farm shouldn't be a hindrance to those locating nearby.

"It's not my intention to avoid agricultural odors in any area," the mayor said. "Food is a main source of existence. If we think we can produce food without odors, we're only fooling ourselves."

"There may be times when there are certain odors, but it's not my intention to interrupt anyone's existing operation, whether we approve or not."

The matter was referred to planning committee for further discussion.
