Oppose Plan

STOUFFVILLE — Objectors to an application from Emmanuel International for a zoning amendment will be asked to attend a public meeting on the subject.

The motion was approved at a meeting of planning board, at which letters were received from four couples in the area, protesting the proposed change from rural to residential on 25 acres on Concession 6.

The letters, which were all copies of each other, objected "to the proposed access road which will enter on Kennedy Road, which is in the immediate vicinity of our property."

The writers said they felt it would present "a safety hazard, and the changed land use will have a downgrading factor on our land values."

Mayor Eldred King said the matter had been approved in principle. The writers should be notified and invited to the Ontario Municipal Board hearing on the proposal.

"Nice to see they all write the same," commented Councillor Bill Kamps, after reading the letters.

STOUFFVILLE — The congregation of Stouffville United Church will celebrate its 129th anniversary this Sunday, (Oct. 31). Worship time is 11 a.m.

Guest speaker is Rev. Donald Johns, minister of Parkwood United Church, Toronto. Following the service, a pot-luck lunch will be enjoyed.

The former Wesleyan Methodist Church had its beginning in Stouffville back in 1853. The present structure, the third since its inception as a congregation, was dedicated in 1892. Due to continual growth, there have been two extensions; one in 1950 and another in 1977.
