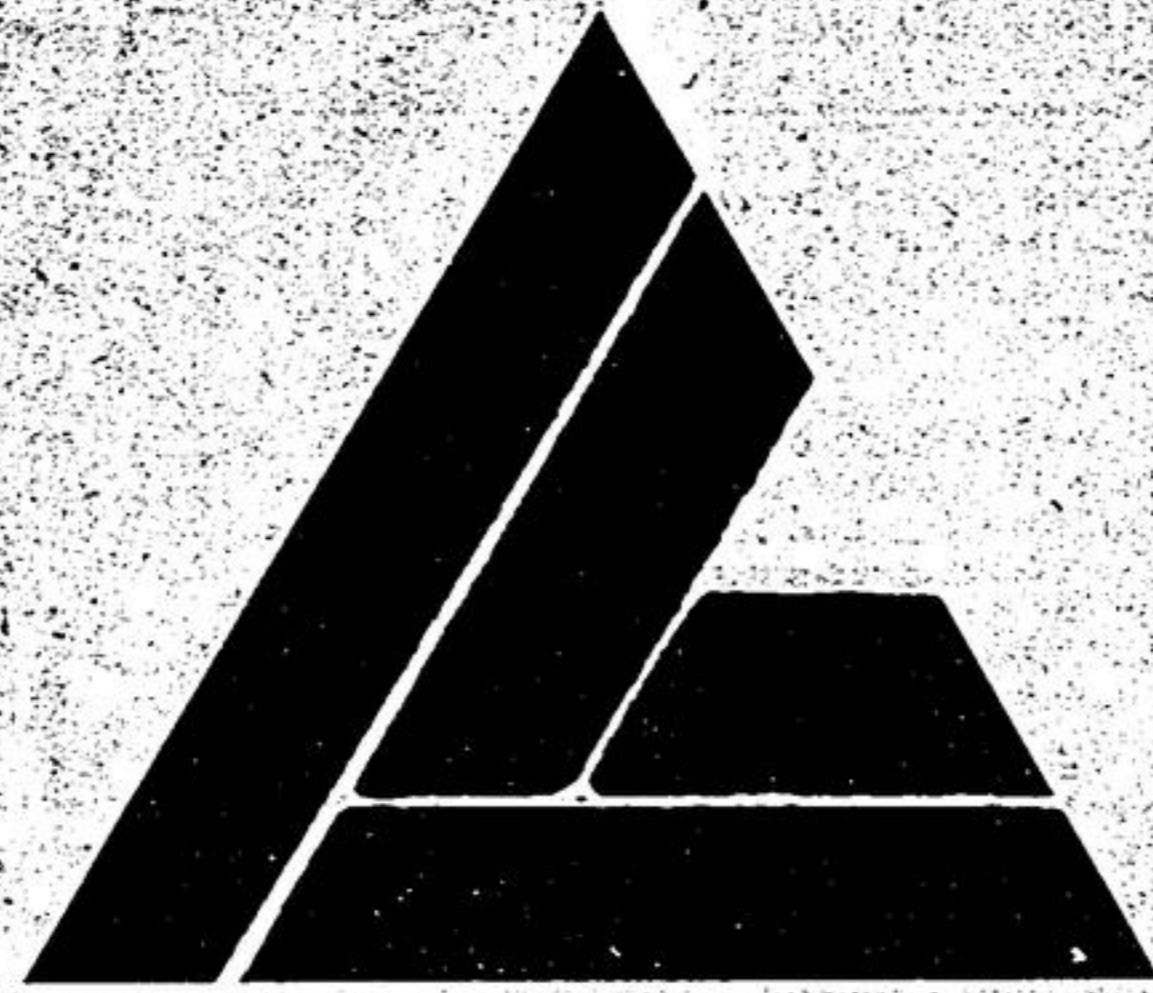
Mrs. Carol Stametion of the Theatre Arts Department, is the director. General admission is \$1. Scrooge would have liked that.

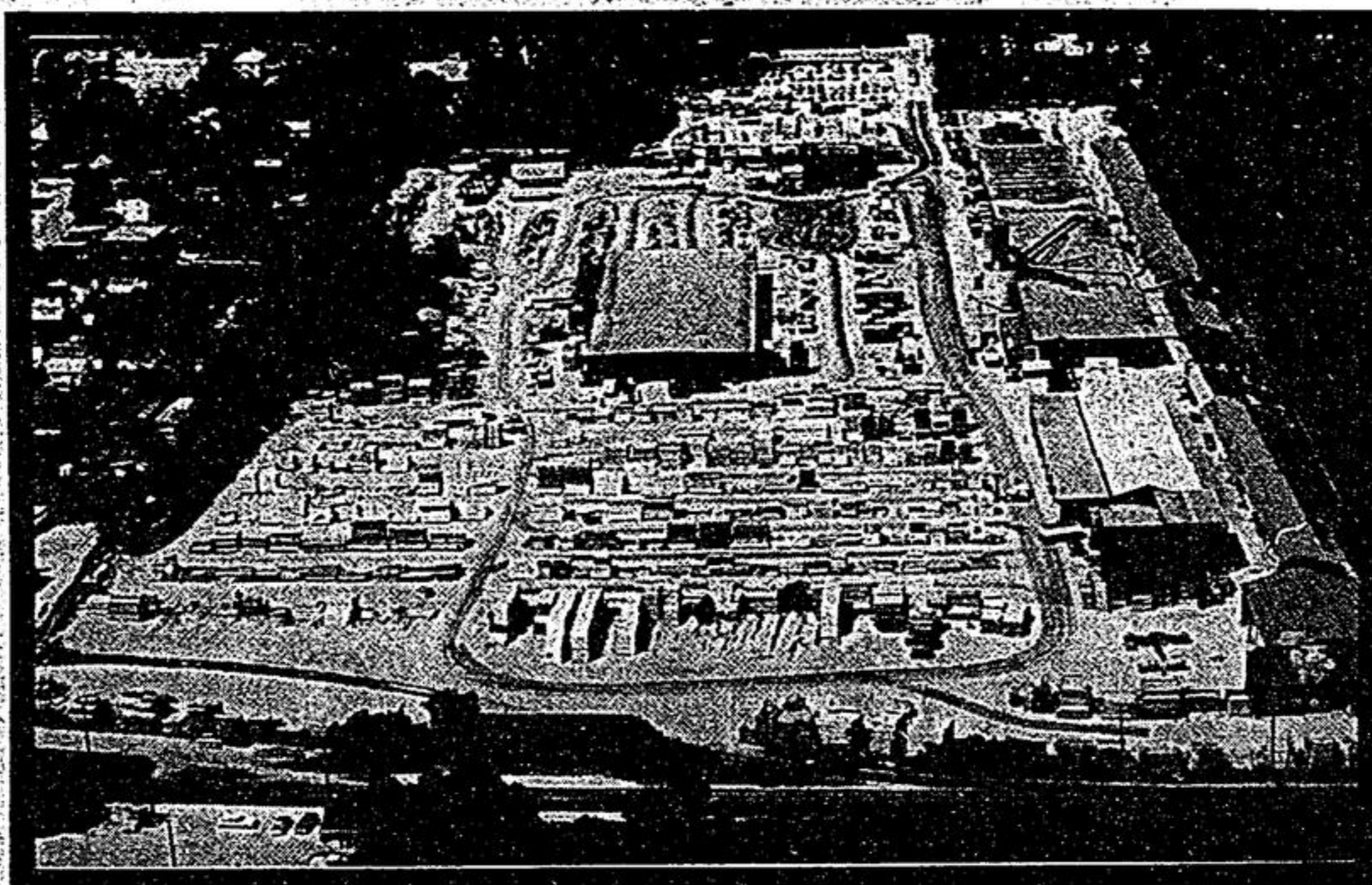

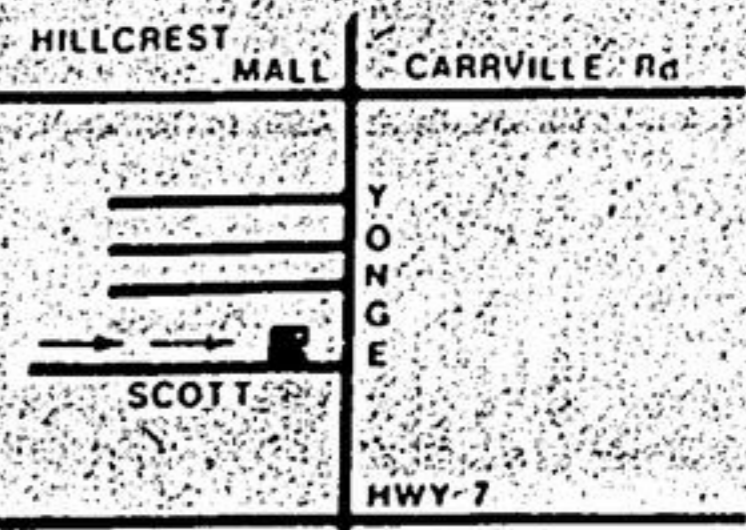
