

Garbage-and its solution

YORK CENTRE: If less than one teaspoon of many industrial wastes is fatal to an adult, what would 1.15 million tonnes of industrial waste do to an entire population?

This is the question being addressed by York Centre MPP Don Cousens in his presentation to the Ontario Waste Management Corporation.

Don Cousens said: "With thousands of tonnes of waste being improperly dumped every year, effective waste management is one of the most pressing environmental issues facing Ontario. In 1981, Ontario generated 1.15 million tonnes of industrial waste, of which 5% simply 'vanished'; 25% entered the sewage system and 15% was mixed with municipal solid waste."

Mr. Cousens stressed the importance of politicians, environmentalists and society working together in developing a trust so that these environmentally sensitive issues are dealt with properly.

Cousens offers the following recommendations:

- (1). Strong regulations and a system of regulation enforcement should be recommended by Ontario Waste Management Corporation to prevent indiscriminate dumping.
- (2). Emphasis should be placed on recycling and waste reduction aspects of waste management and not solely on treatment and disposal.
- (3). Private sector entry and management control should be made possible by (a). Reducing any monopoly control OWMC may have. (b). Initiating research and development in unison with the appropriate ministries to pin-point areas for private sector entry.
