Share park

WHITCHURCH — A development that would allow each resident to share a private park, was proposed to a meeting of planning board last week. The 67-lot, estate-residential complex, would be located on more than 131 acres along the north side of Bethesda Road and the east side of Woodbine Avenue. Randy Alcorn of Alcorn and Associates told the meeting. He was appearing for the owners, Schmid and Lang of Toronto. The project would be known as Bethesda Estates. Alcorn said that the average lot size would be two acres, with only four under an acre. Ponds would be located throughout the area to the north and northeast, which was not suitable for farmland. There would be a private park, or "open space" area, with the home owners having shares. "That would reduce the expense to the municipality in maintenance," Alcorn said. A motion by Mayor Eldred King for further study, was approved.
