A Public Hearing will be held by the Planning Committee of the Council of the Town of Markham to consider a Secondary Plan (PD 23-1) for the North Don Mills Industrial Planning District (Planning District No. 23).

The subject lands of the proposed Secondary Plan are shown on the map below.

The purpose of the Secondary Plan is to establish a detailed land use plan conforming to the general industrial designation of the lands by the Official Plan of the Town of Markham. A basic pattern of internal roads is also intended to be established, as well as other policies for the development of the lands.

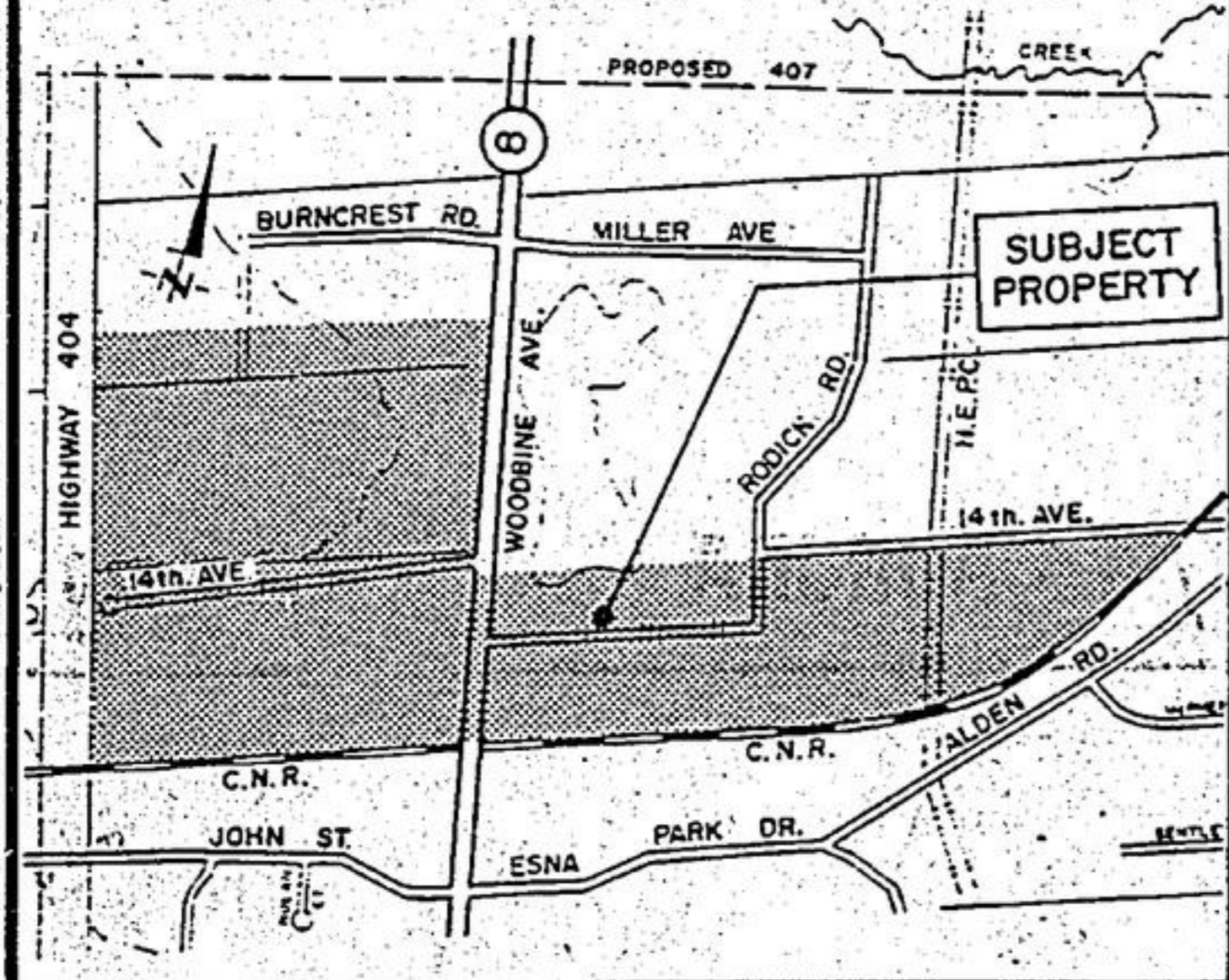
Actual development of the lands will, in addition, require the prior approval of plans of subdivision, appropriate zoning by-laws, as well as site plan approvals and agreements.

You are invited to attend the Hearing and to state your comments on the proposed Secondary Plan. Should you be unable to attend, written submissions will be received up to the time of the Hearing.

The proposed Secondary Plan may be examined at the Planning Office.
