Ceremony

STOUFFVILLE — An addition to St. James Presbyterian Church, Main Street East, Stouffville, will be officially opened at a Service of Dedication, Sunday, Jan. 30.

The project, started in November and costing \$120,000, was recently completed.

The two-storey extension will accommodate a church office, a church nursery, washrooms and meeting rooms. A new entrance and wider stairs will make both the lower auditorium and the sanctuary more accessible.

The primary work was completed by A. and S. Construction of Stouffville. As well, much volunteer time was contributed by the congregation which enabled renovations to the existing building to include a new kitchen, furnace room and storage area. The committee chairman was John Campbell of Ballantrae.

The Service of Dedication will begin at 3 p.m. This will be followed by a ribbon-cutting ceremony, a tour of the new facility and a social hour. The event is open to the entire community and 'all' will be made very welcome.
