Woman guilty in fraud against a K. Mart Store in Thornhill, was given a conditional discharge and placed on a two year term of probation in Newmarket Provincial Court recently. Sharon Buccichio, alias Fontaine, was charged by York Regional Police last May after she issued a total of \$225 worth of worthless cheques for purchases she made at the Thornhill store, then returned the goods for a refund. The court was told that the Richmond Hill woman and her husband had gone to the store together and had both been charged as a result. The Richmond Hill man had pleaded guilty to the offences on an earlier court appearance. Counsel for the young woman said Ms. Buccichio's husband had been the instigator of the offences. He told the court that his client has since left her husband and is living with her parents. In handing down a conditional discharge, Judge R.G. Pearce ordered Ms. Buccichio to pay K. Mart restitution for its losses.
