Horse show

More than 125 horses and ponies will take part in the Markham Lane Stables upcoming Junior A Horse Show. Admission to the show (chaired by Markham Lanes Manager Diana Gill) is free and open to the public. A snack bar will be available. Seating is provided at the indoor ring.

A 19-year-old Willowdale man, convicted on a charge of theft in Newmarket Provincial Court, has been fined \$250 by Judge R.G. Pearse.

Terence Finegan was charged by York Regional Police last summer following the theft of 25 tapes from a Markham area home.

The court was told that Mr. Finegan had attended a party at the home prior to the theft of the tapes.

Judge Pearse noted that the youth had committed the offence while on probation following an earlier conviction. "You were flying in the face of a court order," Judge Pearse told the 19-year-old man in handing down sentence.

The public is invited to swim during the competition, which will run from 1:30 to 4 p.m.
