Inuit art featured

The 15th edition of the Markham Kiwanis Club's annual art show will not only be the biggest in the event's history, but will be the first time, feature 100 Inuit sculptures by eight artists from Baffin Island.

The show, called 'Art '83', is slated for May 12 to 15 at the Markham Community Arena (Hwy. 7 and 48). According to a press release, over 200 artists will be displaying 1,200 works of art in what has become known as Canada's largest annual sale of Canadian art.

According to the Kiwanis Club press release, the Artists' Night "will provide an opportunity for the public to meet and discuss various paintings with the artists."

The show runs Thursday, Friday, Saturday from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m., and Sunday from noon to 4 p.m. Admission is \$2 per person. Seniors and children will be admitted free.

All proceeds from the show go to community service projects backed by the Markham Kiwanis Club.
