What would you do if someone near you was having a heart attack?

Most people simply watch in horror, unprepared to assist. Yet, according to the Ontario Heart Foundation, many heart attack victims, who die each year, before reaching professional treatment, could be saved through simple knowledge and prompt action.

Knowing the signals of heart attack and having a predetermined action plan are steps every person should take to be ready in an emergency.

The most common signal identified by the Ontario Heart Foundation is an uncomfortable pressure; squeezing, fullness or pain in the centre of the chest behind the breastbone which may radiate to the neck, shoulders, or arms. It need not be severe. There also may be signs such as sweating, nausea, shortness of breath or a feeling of weakness.
