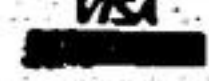

Shifty tax moves

STOUFFVILLE — Those in the York Regional political area must "all learn to become better lobbyists," York Regional Chairman Bob Forhan told a recent meeting of Town Council.

The chairman dropped by to "present highlights of Regional activities during 1982 and provide an indication of what this year holds in store."

Referring to the Region's \$81 million budget for 1983-84 (\$31,469,900, net Regional cost), Forhan said that Stouffville's growth rate had helped York establish a balanced budget for the second year in a row, the only such Region to do so.

He termed the matter "a collective effort" among the municipalities, which had "re-confirmed themselves as a powerful economic force in the Province of Ontario."

He said that, in such matters as roads, where there was a decrease of "four to five per cent," a withdrawal of grants shifted the tax burden to Regional taxpayers.

"It is so shifty, nobody is saying anything," he said. "It makes it more difficult at the municipal budget level when we're not playing with the same cards as last year."

"We have to learn to become better lobbyists," he said.

Regional road projects in Whitechurch-Stouffville, included asphalt re-surfacing of the Ninth Line from Musselman's Lake to Aurora Road, and the conversion of traffic signals at four Stouffville Road intersections — Woodbine, Warden, Kennedy and McCowan. There, signals are activated by approaching cars.

New lighting will also be installed at Warden Ave. and Kennedy Road intersections, with Bloomington Road, and the intersection of Aurora Road and Concession 5.

Regional Council had authorized property purchases "in anticipation of the McCowan Road (reconstruction) project in the area between 16th Avenue and the Stouffville Road," he said.

Also in that area, land had been acquired for such projects as the jog elimination at Stouffville and Kennedy Rds., and the section of the Ninth Line between Bloomington Road and Musselman's Lake.

In concluding his remarks, the chairman said: "In spite of what appear to be ambitious programs across the Region, I assure you that, with the exception of the items I mentioned, we are contemplating no new or expanded services in 1983."

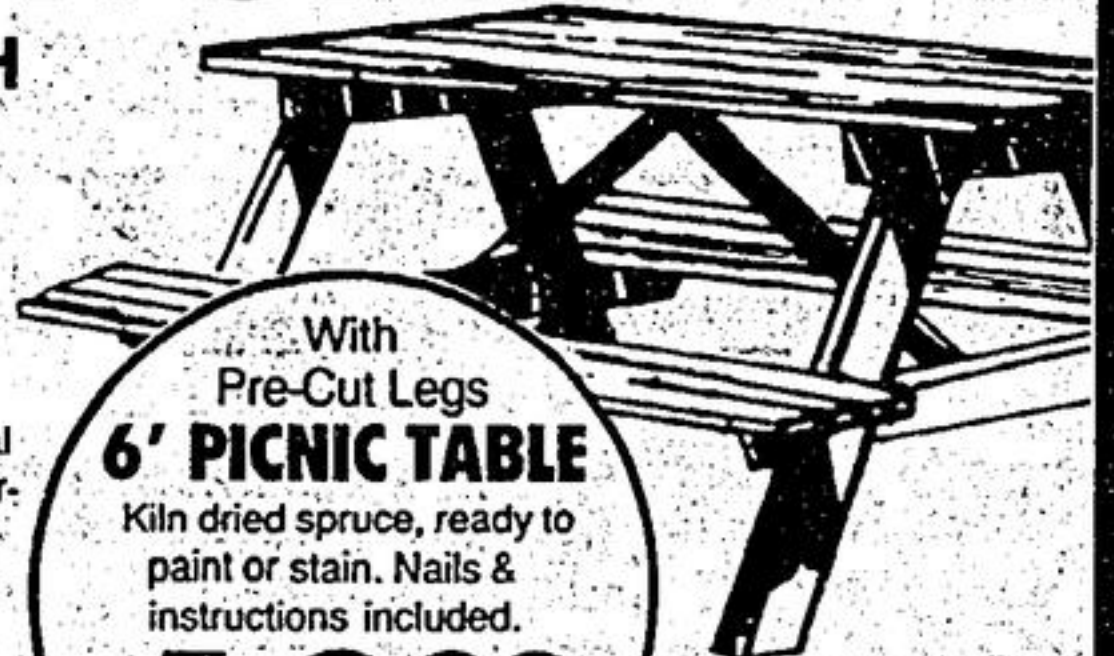

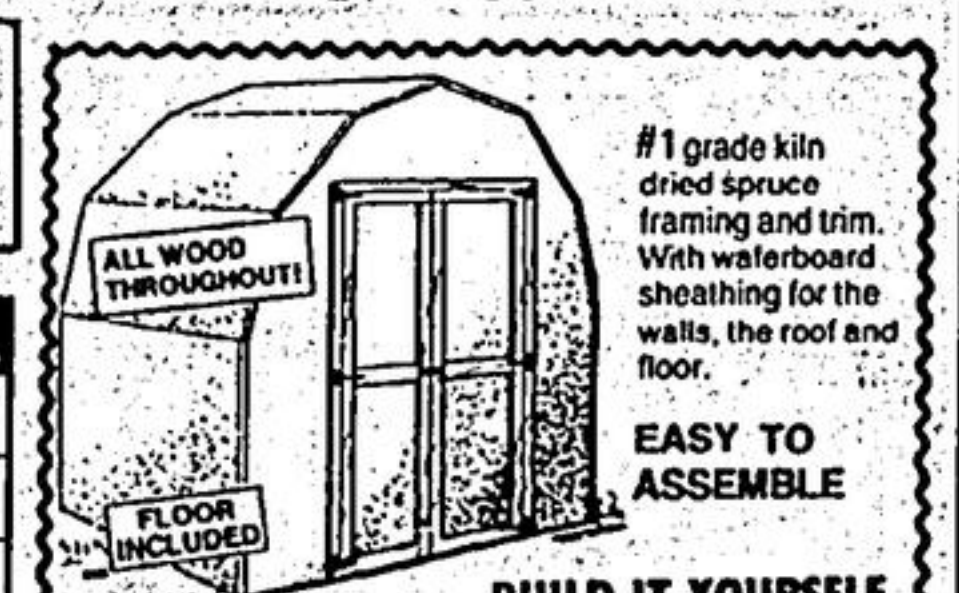
