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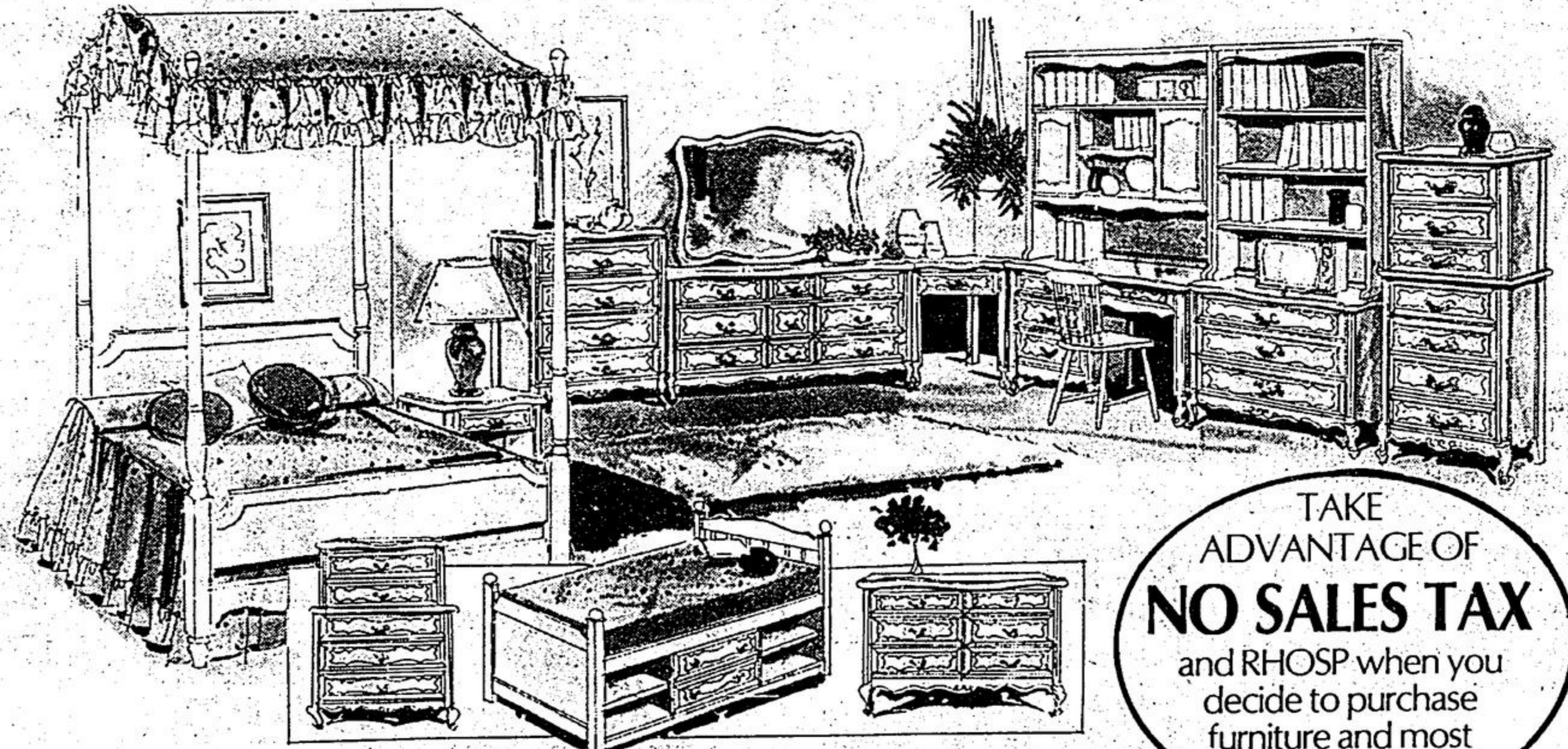

**NOTICE**

The Ontario Planning and Development Act, R.S.O. 1980, Section 6.

The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing has received a request for an amendment to the Parkway Belt West Plan, July 1978, by Leitch Transport Limited and M. Teubner. The amendment proposes that:

(i) Section 6.5.3(p) be added to the Plan allowing prestige industrial, office commercial and limited supporting retail and service commercial development on the subject lands at a maximum density not greater than 40% of the lot area (exclusive of parking), subject to certain conditions and

(ii) Lands covered by the Parkway Belt West Plan within Lots 9 and 10, Conc. 2 and 3, in the Town of Markham, located east of the Richmond Hill tributary of the German Mills Creek, north of the proposed Hwy. 407 and west of Hwy. 404 be redesignated. Specifically, lands designated "General Complementary Use Area" (approximately 74 ha, 183 acres) in the Woodbridge-Markham Northern Link would be redesignated to a "Special Complementary Use Area".

Although a deadline of July 6, 1983 was given in the previous public notice, an extension is now in effect. Comments and submissions on the amendment may be made to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing until August 18, 1983 at the above address.
