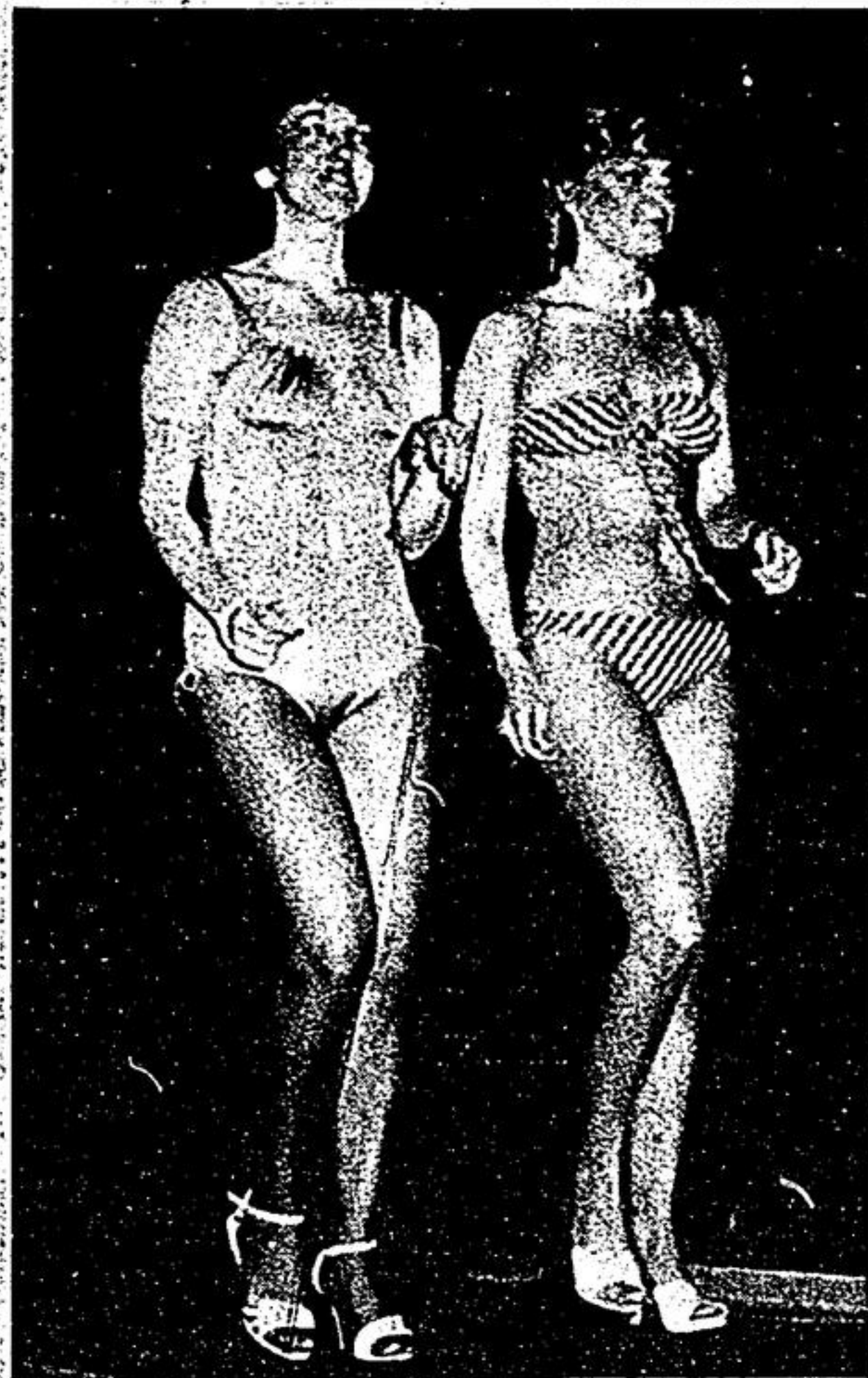


Models display latest fashions

All set for tennis are Ron Brillinger, Main Street West and Julie Chambers, Tenth Line South. Both formal and informal dress was featured.



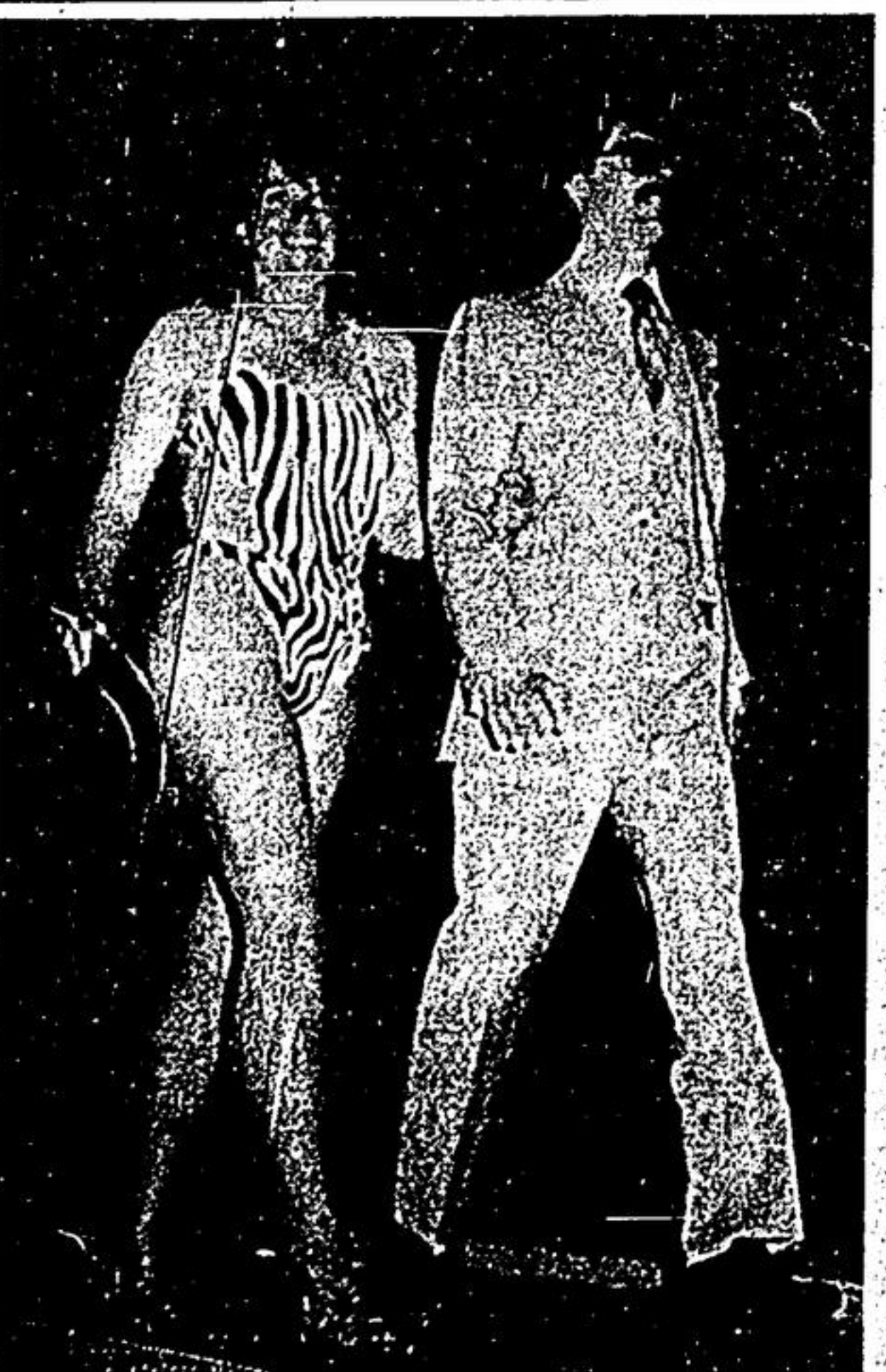
Julie Chambers, Tenth Line South and Bob Cochran, Stouffer Street, displayed attractive yet practical summer wear with these outfits.
