Town fights zoning plan

STOUFFVILLE — The Whitechurch-Stouffville Town Council has agreed to fight and appeal the Committee of Adjustment's recent decision to grant permission for a change in land use for the selling and storing of firewood in the Ringwood area.

The application was recently made by Paul and Bruce Peritalo to re-zone Lot 35, Conc. 8 on the east side of Hwy. 48 from the present non-conforming use to commercial use. The application had been denied by council, but granted by the members of the Committee of Adjustment on September 8.

The Committee allowed the re-zoning as long as certain conditions were maintained. These conditions included: the operation of the firewood outlet would only be allowed for two years from the date of the decision; the sale of firewood would only be allowed on the south side of the road and no closer than the south dwelling; the outlet would conform to the sketch plan which was submitted with the application; and the firewood storage area would be restricted to the rear of the east warehouse.

"This is certainly not a proper stop for the sale of firewood and we have no control over how they maintain the site," argued Councillor Wilf Morley.

Town Council has 30 days to appeal the decision.

Santa will come Dec. 3

STOUFFVILLE — Santa's coming to town.

At Tuesday's meeting, Town Council agreed to help financially assist the Stouffville Kinsmen 1983 Santa Claus Parade to be held on Saturday, Dec. 3 from 2 to 4 p.m.

Council agreed to donate \$2,400 to the Kinsmen Club to help with the parade's expenses. The Kinsmen Club estimated the parade would cost a total of \$5,900.

According to Kinsmen President, Stephen Upton, the parade will be similar to the 1982 parade with approximately 12 bands, 7 majorette groups, and between 30 to 35 floats or marching groups.

Town Council also passed a bylaw on Tuesday which allowed the closing of Main Street (Highway 47) from the tenth Conc. Line north to Westlawn Cres. and from the tenth Conc. Line north (Highway 47) from Main Street to Stouffer Street.

Also from 1 p.m. until after the two-hour parade there will be no parking on Main Street from Baker Ave. to Albert Street.

STOUFFVILLE — The Whitechurch-Stouffville Town Council voted Tuesday in support of allowing a two-day hayride event sponsored by Giles Chevrolet-Oldsmobile Ltd., 331 Main Street West, Stouffville.
