

Fund raising activities gearing up

STOUFFVILLE — A United Way flag will fly outside the Whitchurch-Stouffville Municipal offices for the next six weeks as the annual United Way campaign kicks off with Stouffville taking an active part.

Stouffville's United Way Chairman, Fran Sainsbury, held a luncheon Monday with her volunteers to spearhead the event. Mrs. Sainsbury, who was the Whitchurch-Stouffville 1982 Citizen of the Year, has 17 volunteers helping with the campaign from September 26 until November 11. She said her goal is to double or triple Stouffville's

1982 donation, which was more than \$10,000.

"The more we give the more we receive back," explained Mrs. Sainsbury. "We hope to increase the giving."

She said there are 25 agencies, spread throughout York Region, who are activity working at the fund-raising project. This is the first year Stouffville has had a chairman during the campaign and although this is Mrs. Sainsbury's first chairmanship, she plans to fight her hardest to raise money.

The volunteers participating will find a partner to help them, which doubles the staff, and they will approach various individuals, businesses, and agencies for their financial donations.

"This is just straight fund-raising for those less fortunate," said Mrs. Sainsbury. She said last year's campaign in Stouffville wasn't as productive as it could have been for the number of residents and businesses.

"It was about 80 cents per household and we thought that was a poor showing."

Some of the prospective areas to be approached for donations include construction and farm dealerships, real estate offices, industrial parks, and the residential areas. Mrs. Sainsbury said volunteers will campaign to these areas with pam-

phlets and information dealing with the United Way, information on how the donated money is broken down, and where it goes.

"There's a lot more benefit than you think," she said. "It (donations) doesn't go back to Toronto. It stays in York Region."

The only direct agency in Stouffville to receive donations directly is the Stouffville Family Life Centre. One-third of all the money raised in Stouffville comes back to the Family Life Centre stated Mrs. Sainsbury.

According to Rev. Ted Green, who is chairman of the Stouffville Family Life Centre, a lot of United Way money benefits Stouffville residents through various other

agencies who are not located in Whitchurch-Stouffville, but provide services to residents living there.

"The money donated to the Family Life Centre enables the centre to operate," explained Mr. Green. "It makes it possible to operate an office in Stouffville...it basically helps a centre, like the Stouffville Family Life, to exist."

Mr. Green said the money is used for basic overhead like incidentals and maintenance.

"The United Way is fairly significant...that's basically the only funding we have," he concluded.
