

Need \$5 million

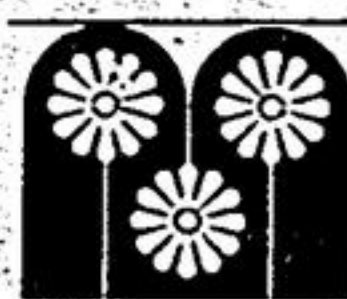
STOUFFVILLE Residential canvass for the Markham Stouffville Hospital will commence Nov. 1. Canvassers are now being recruited and each is being asked to call on 30 homes. Five hundred persons will be re-

quired to cover the area. In Stouffville, the canvass director and organizer is Lorne Boadway, Maytree Avenue. As of Sept. 22, just over \$2 million had been raised. This is 40 per cent of the \$5 million goal—the local share of the

capital cost of building and equipping the hospital. Campaign officials are confident the target can be reached by the end of 1983. "The local share of funding (the \$5,000,000) must be in place," Keith

Sutherland, trustee and deputy chairman of the Hospital Building Fund told The Tribune. "If funds are committed before the end of 1983, there's a possibility construction can begin by October, 1984."

Mr. Sutherland stressed the importance of local commitments now! The Ministry of Health will not clear further design stages until this assurance is guaranteed. There is a five-year pledge payment period.

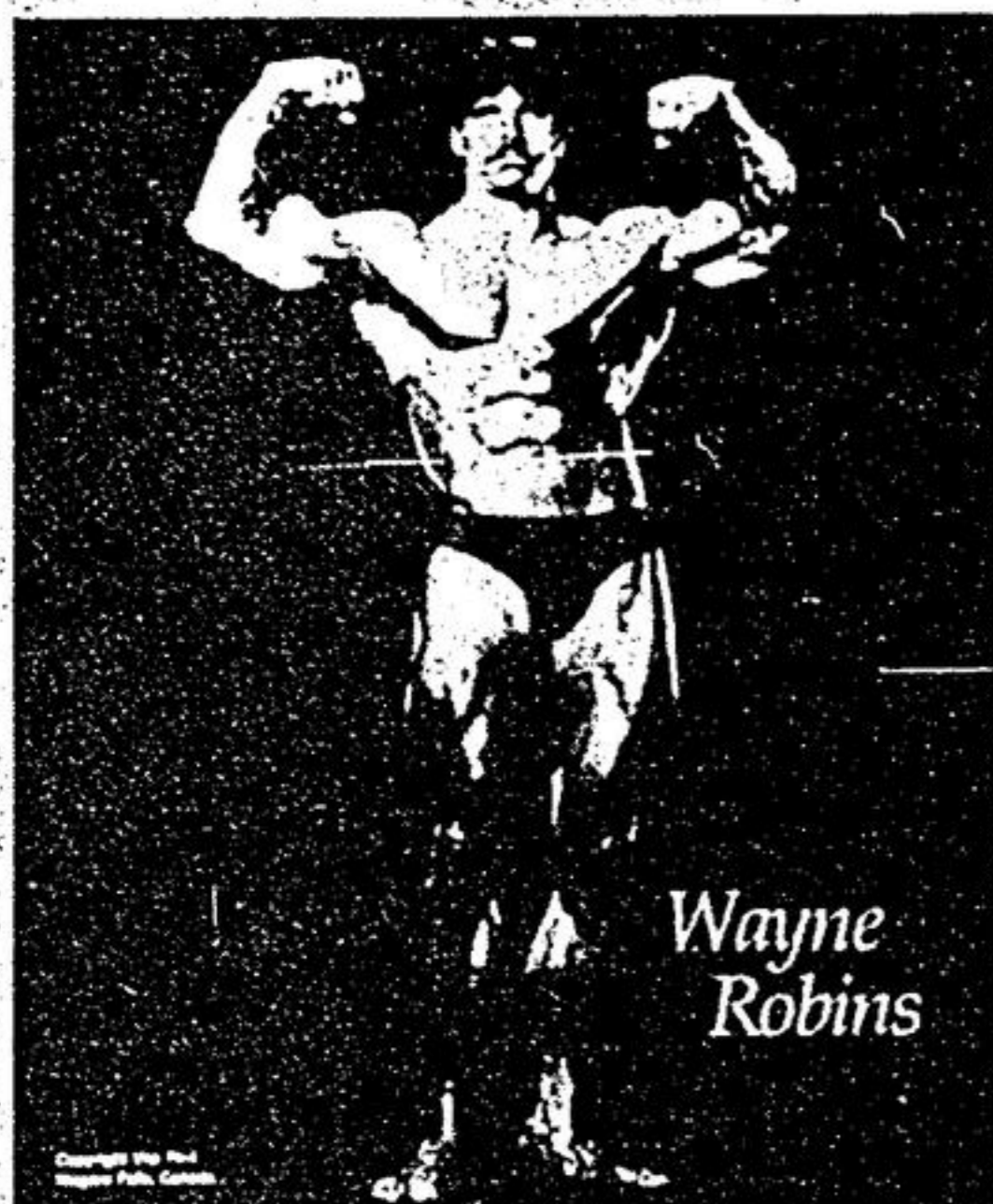

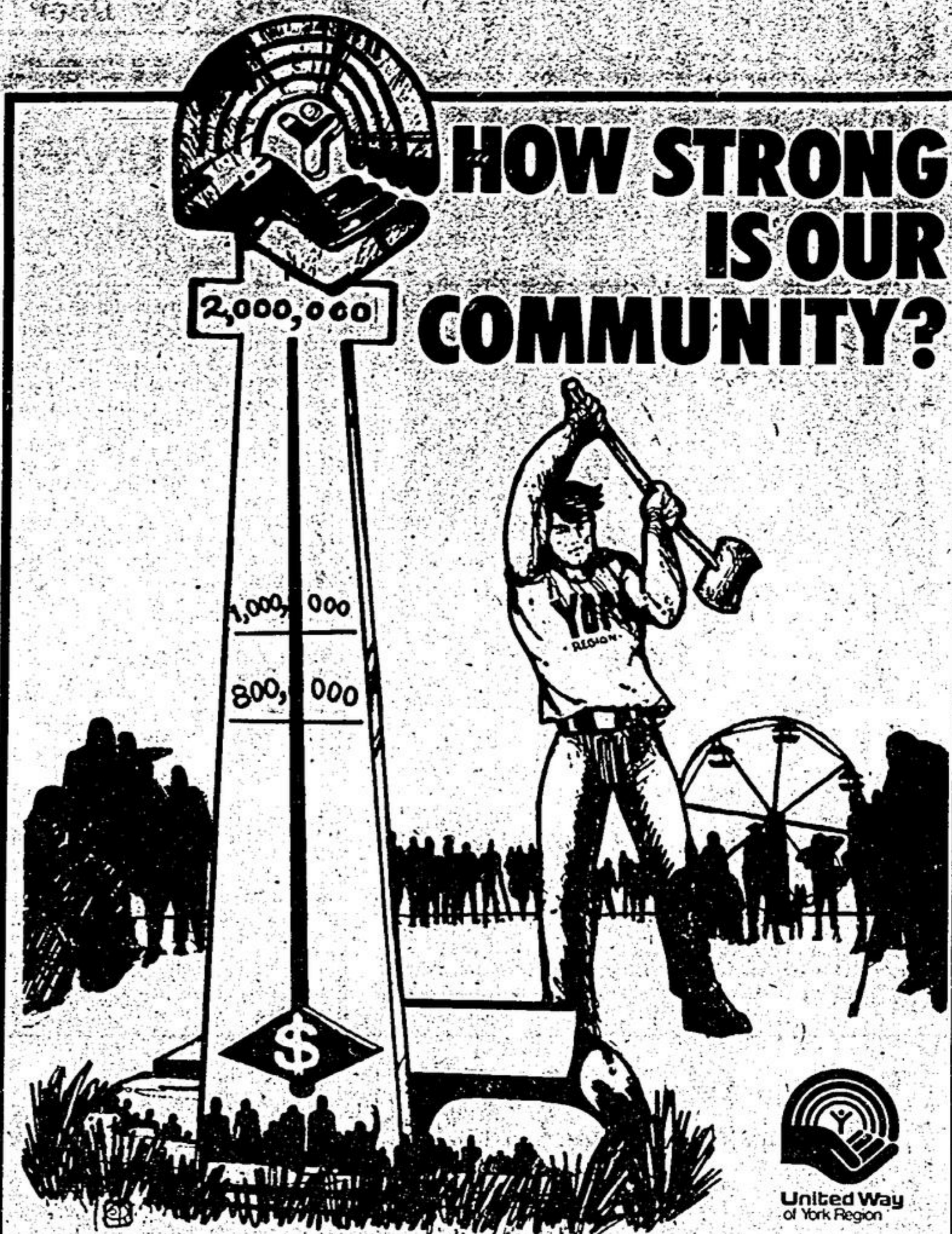
