1. The Council of The Corporation of the town of Whitchurch-Stouffville intends to reconstruct the following roads: - namely, Cedarvale Blvd., Rosehill Dr., Elmvale Blvd., Maple Cres. and Balsam Blvd. as follows:

The estimated cost of the work is \$300,000.00 of which \$75,000.00 is to be paid by the Corporation and \$150,000.00 is to be paid by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications and the estimated cost per metre frontage is \$30.46 (\$9.28 per foot frontage). The special assessment is to be paid in 10 annual instalments.

3. Persons desiring to petition against undertaking the work must do so on or before the 5th day of November, 1983.
