A MESSAGE from your BUILDING AND BY-LAW DEPARTMENT

DID YOU KNOW THAT:

1. The owner of a privately owned swimming pool is required to obtain a permit for and shall erect AND MAINTAIN an enclosure surrounding the entire swimming pool area to make such body of water not readily accessible to small children.
2. You, the pool owner, are responsible for the maintenance of safety standards in the swimming pool area, 365 days a year.
3. Swimming pools installed prior to 1975, may not conform to the current Swimming Pool By-law. Please contact the Building and By-Laws Department for an inspection.
4. That the owners of all dogs are required to obtain a licence for them.
5. That all dogs must be kept under control and on a leash when being walked.
6. Pumps, Motors, Condensers and other mechanical equipment relative to Air Conditioning, Heating, Filtering etc., when located in the side yard of your residential property is subject to set back restrictions.
7. Prior to installing or constructing a carport, garage, shed, patio deck, fireplace, addition or alterations to your home, you are required to obtain a BUILDING PERMIT.
8. Dwellings and additions to, including garages and accessory buildings are subject to minimum set backs from the property lines.
9. Residential property line fences are subject to height restrictions.
