## Site plan rejected

**STOUFFVILLE** — A local resident has again come before the Planning Advisory Committee with an updated site plan for a commercial/residential building proposal, and again the committee has turned her down.

Marie Adams, Main Street East, Stouffville, presented her revised proposal related to a site at the corner of Main Street West and Albert Street South, but again it failed to meet committee standards. They refused to receive it.

Mrs. Adams' revised site plan included such changes as—an additional 16 parking spaces; an increase in apartment units from six to eight and increased commercial store space.

However, the committee rejected the application because there was no allowance for a buffer zone around the building; there was a lack of proper landscaping; too high a density; the asphalt went to a zero lot line on the east and south parking areas and illuminated signs. The committee suggested the density should be decreased by 25 per cent and the commercial and residential units should also be decreased by 25 per cent.

The site plan will be subject to a public hearing.
