The \$100 Music Mania Award was won by Michael McGinn, R.R. 4, Stouffville and presented by show director Elizabeth Fraser.



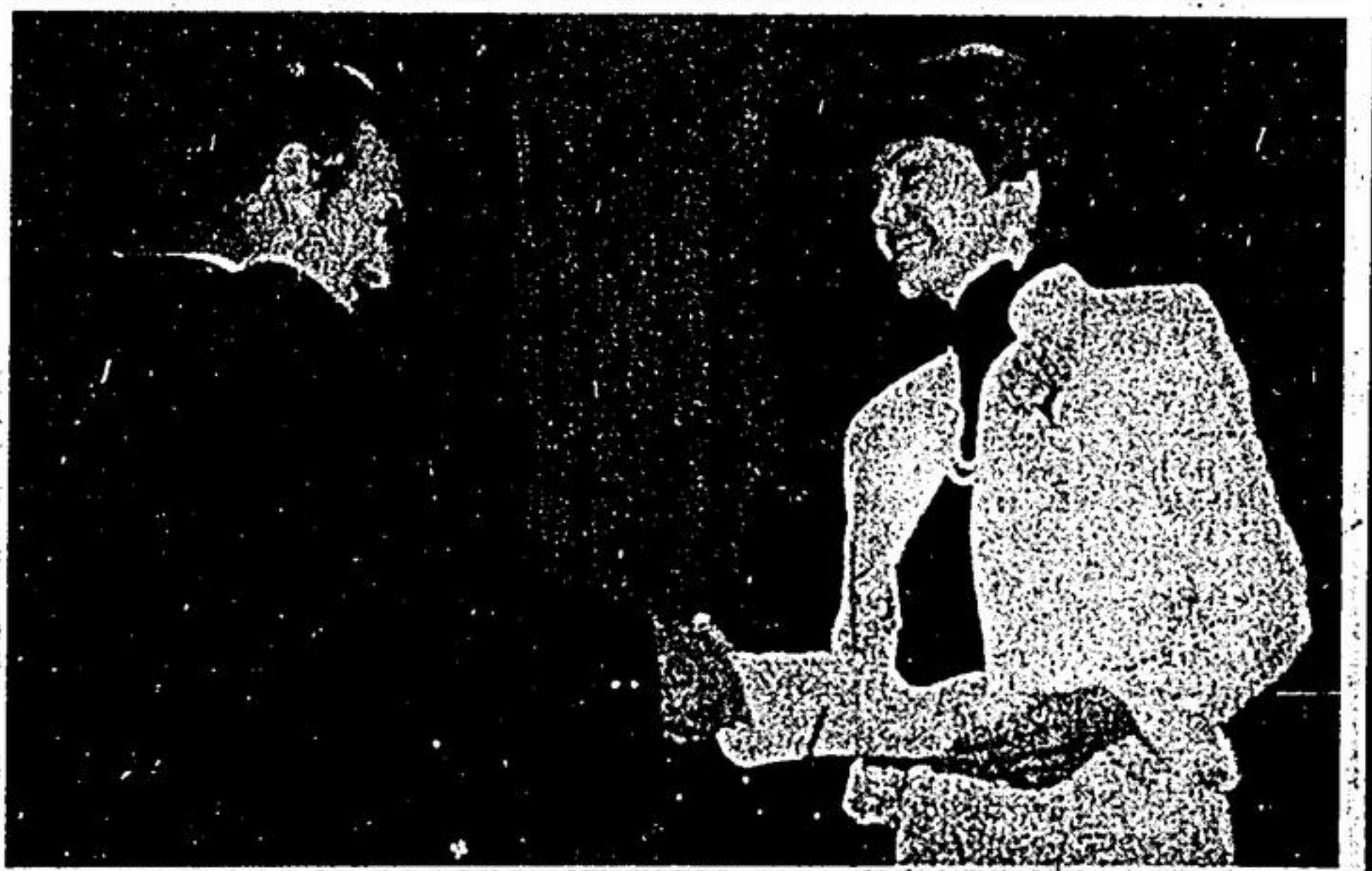
Patricia Davis, a graduate of Grade 12, received her diploma from Supt. of School Operations, Kenneth McDonald.
