

# Former Cashel man excellent veterinarian

Dr. J. Duncan Smith, formerly of Cashel, died suddenly, Thursday, at his residence in Kentville, Nova Scotia. He was 55.

Born at R.R. 1, Unionville, the son of Grace (Duncan) Smith and the late Alfred G. Smith, he received his elementary education at Melville Public School and later, Stouffville High, then located at Summitview.

He graduated from Ontario Veterinary College at Guelph in 1952 and worked for a short time with Dr. Ronald Smith of Stouffville.

For thirty years, Dr. Smith practiced veterinary medicine in Kentville and

was recognized as one of the foremost authorities in poultry pathology in North America. He was president of the Cornwallis Veterinary Association and past-president of the Nova Scotia Veterinary Medical Association.

Dr. Smith was a past-president of Kentville Lions Club and held positions on the Kentville Town Council, including the position of deputy-reeve.

He was a member in the congregation of Kentville Baptist Church.

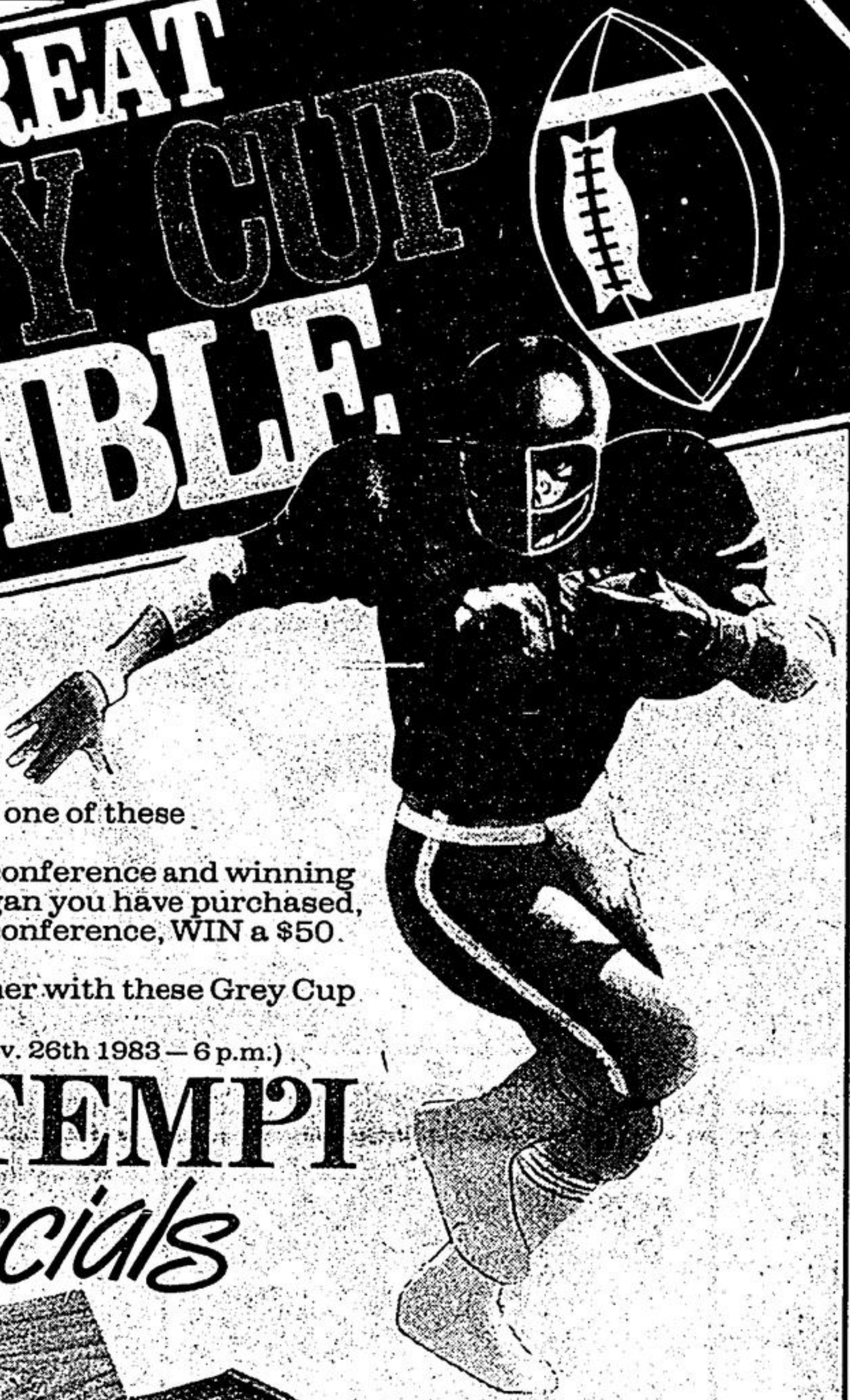
An excellent athlete, Duncan established records as a middle-distance runner while a student at Stouffville High. In later years, he took up curling, play-

ing on four provincial championship teams. He was president of the Gloscap Curling Club and a member of the Royal Caledonia Curling Club.

Service was held Saturday at Kentville Baptist Church with interment, Elm Grove Cemetery.

Surviving, besides his wife, the former Alice Lane, are three sons, Dr. Mark Smith of Pembroke; Scott in Calgary; Anthony at home; one daughter, Katherine (Mrs Gerald Mahar) of Kentville; one brother, Denton of Stouffville; two sister, Patricia Hill of Farmington, Michigan; Margaret Walsom of Newmarket and two grandchildren.

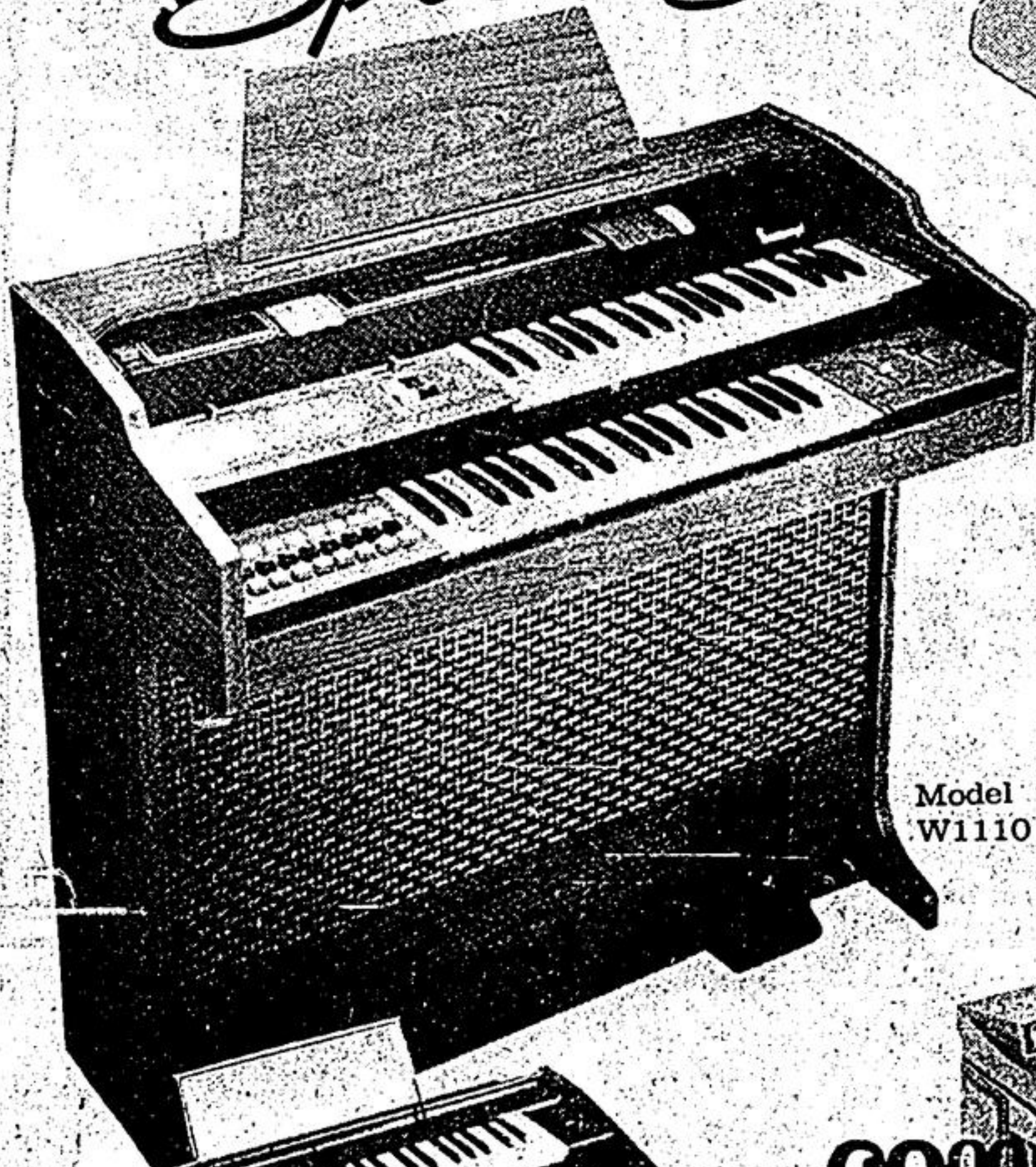

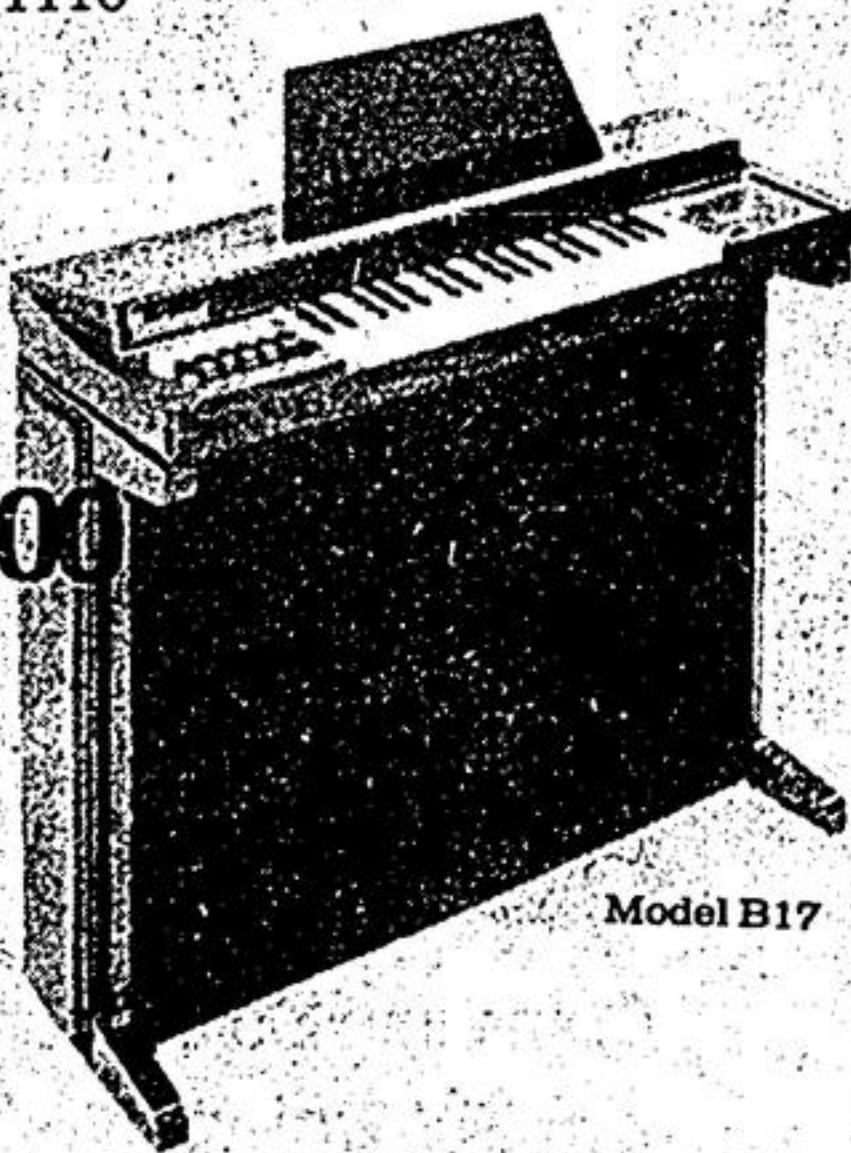
