

The need is urgent

Dear Jim:
We wish to thank The Tribune and the community for their support of the local project of collecting food and clothing for distribution among the needy both here and downtown Toronto.

We have been encouraged by the response to the food baskets conveniently located in the window of the A & P and on the counter at I.G.A.

The need for food is great. As recent newspaper articles have indicated, the situation is serious, particularly with winter coming on.

We wish to describe briefly, the four centres to which we deliver food on a weekly basis:

SCOTT MISSION is located on Spadina Avenue. Each morning, about 400 are fed

here at 10 a.m., with an overflow of from 150 to 225 people at eleven. In addition, Scott Mission supplies groceries and clothing to families whose benefits have expired or to referrals from another agency.

STOP 103 is staffed by two Anglican brothers. They counsel people seeking employment, accommodation and provide language assistance. They also provide groceries for the needy.

FRED VICTOR MISSION is located on Queen Street. There is equal need for food here along with men's clothing. They sleep and feed approximately 200 men each day, providing breakfast and supper on a voucher basis. They also provide lunch for 90 additional street-walkers and groceries to needy families.

GOOD SHEPHERD LODGE is located

on Queen Street. They feed up to 480 people per day every afternoon at four. They also provide bed and breakfast for 30 men each evening on a voucher system of five nights every two to three months because of the number.

We consider this a very worthwhile project and would ask the kind citizens of Whitechurch-Stouffville to share something each week from their food carts. As stated, the baskets are located in the two supermarkets. Men's clothing can be left at the Anglican Church.

The need is genuine. We thank everyone for continued support.
