## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville proposes to pass a by-law to facilitate the property change requested by The Regional Municipality of Durham necessitated by the reconstruction of the intersection of the 10th Concession Line and Durham Regional Road No. 30 by authorizing the acquisition, dedication and disposition of certain lands designated as Parts 1 to 10 on a Reference Plan deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of York Region (No. 65) as Number 65R-6112, all references hereafter being to parts on the said Reference Plan.

Notice is also hereby given that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville proposes by the aforesaid by-law to do the following:

1. Stop up and close that part of the road allowance between Concession 9 and Concession 10 located in front of Part of Lot 13, Concession 10 in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in The Regional Municipality of York, more particularly described as Parts 2, 3 and 5.
2. Authorize the sale of that part of the stopped up and closed road allowance to the owners of the land abutting same.
3. To accept a conveyance of Parts 7, 8 and 9 and to subsequently reconvey Parts 7 and 8 to the owners of the land abutting same when and if necessary.
4. To dedicate Parts 4 and 9 for use as a public highway if and when necessary.
5. To dedicate Parts 1 and 6 to The Regional Municipality of Durham for use as part of the public highway designated as Durham Regional Road Number 30 if and when necessary to do so.

The proposed by-law and a copy of Plan 65R-6112 may be seen at the Clerk's Department at the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville offices, 19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville, Ontario between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

At its meeting to be held in the Council Chambers, 19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville, Ontario on Tuesday, the 10th day of January, 1984, at 8:00 p.m. the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will hear any person who applies to be heard and claims that his land will be prejudicially affected by the by-law.

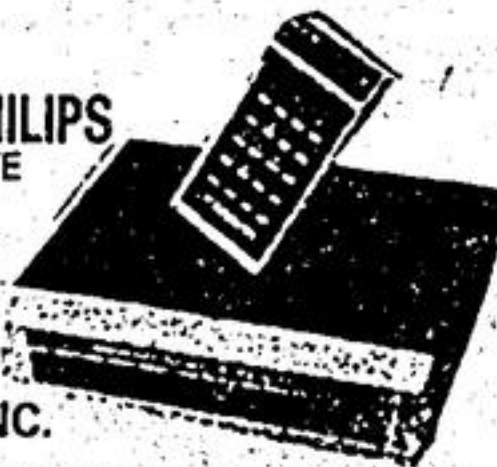

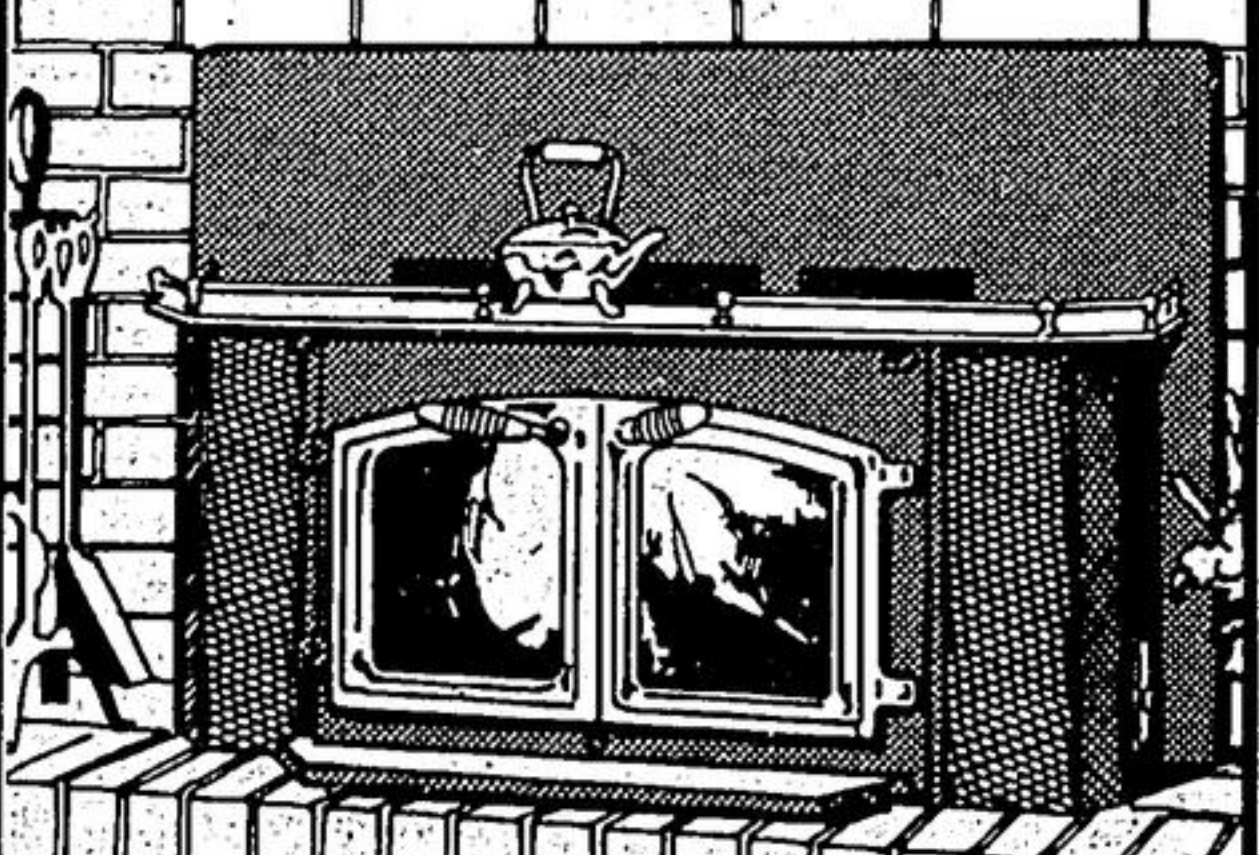
